From folklife festivals to youth artwork projects, and concert series to visual arts exhibits, NAC's support of a breadth of public programs provides residents a rich quality of life—contributing to the health and diversity of Nevada's economy and workforce, increasing tourism, strengthening communities and fostering education through the arts.

## Count the Ways: Nevada Arts Council Grants and Services FY2010

The grants and services provided by the Nevada Arts Council (NAC) in FY2010 and identified in this abbreviated Annual Report speak to the lasting value of a very modest investment of public dollars in Nevada's cultural industry. For each grant and service listed, there are dozens of other stories—all critical contributions to Nevada. The arts are celebrated throughout the Silver State—in small towns, rural areas, and in major metropolitan centers—sustaining individual curiosity, empowering group participatory experiences, benefiting local economies and providing critical educational opportunities. In support of, and in partnership with our grantees and constituents, the Nevada Arts Council remains resolute in its mission to promote the public value of the arts for those who live in and visit our great state.

### The Nevada Arts Council

A nine-member board appointed by the Governor promotes cultural policies and programs to benefit residents throughout the state and makes final decisions on NAC grant allocations. Staff develops and administers programs and projects that support the agency mission and goals in accordance with the NAC strategic plan. As noted below, NAC is divided into six program areas to serve a diverse population.

- Nevada's wealth of professional artists—painters, sculptors, dancers, musicians, filmmakers, actors, writers—are at the heart of quality arts and education programs and lively communities across the state. The **Artist Services Program** provides resources and support for Nevada's creative workforce while promoting opportunities for artists to network and engage with residents through highly valued outreach programs, such as the Nevada Touring Initiative.
- Founded on the belief that the arts have a crucial place in the lifelong learning process of all citizens, the **Arts Education Program** provides school and community artist residencies, grants for innovative arts learning projects in- and out-of-school, professional development support for educators and statewide initiatives that enhance arts curriculum, such as Poetry Out Loud.
- To maintain a healthy cultural infrastructure, the **Community Arts Development Program** employs networking, organizational planning grants and other services to help cities and towns across Nevada develop local programming and strategies to increase participation in the arts. Nevada Circuit Riders extends the NAC's reach by providing affordable consultancies to nonprofit arts and cultural organizations.
- Nevada is rich with traditions, heritage and cultures. Honoring and working with a range of artists and communities—ethnic, tribal, regional, age, occupational, gender, religious and family—the **Folklife Program** documents Nevada's diverse cultural heritage to share with the public through publications, traveling exhibitions, performances, festivals, school programs, workshops, classes and the Nevada Folklife Archives.
- The primary public funding source for Nevada's cultural institutions, arts organizations and public agencies, the **Grants Program** supports a breadth of arts activities across the state. Matching grants are awarded through a highly competitive review process. Though a NAC grant may be a small percentage of a grantee's total budget, the investment extends far beyond actual cash value—leveraging other funding and building local economies.
- The **Public Awareness and Initiatives Program** designs and oversees statewide initiatives and collaborations to meet current needs and challenges of NAC constituencies and to promote the statewide creative industry, such as the Governor's Arts Awards and the online cultural calendar Arts4Nevada.org, strategic planning, survey implementation and other agency-wide activities.

3. This figure represents a one-time increase of \$250,500 from the Federal ARRA/Stimulus Grant, and includes the costs of the Grants Program review process including panelist honoraria, travel and per diem.
4. This figure includes salaries for the Administrative Team (Executive Director, Fiscal Services staff and Administrative Assistant II), rent and other costs associated with the operations of NAC offices in Carson City and Las Vegas.
5. The Western States Arts Federation (WESTAF) is an association of thirteen western state arts agencies. TourWEST, one of

WESTAF's services and programs, supports performing arts presenters throughout the region. The following Nevada organizations received \$18,187.50 in TourWEST grants to support performances during the 2009–2010 season:
