

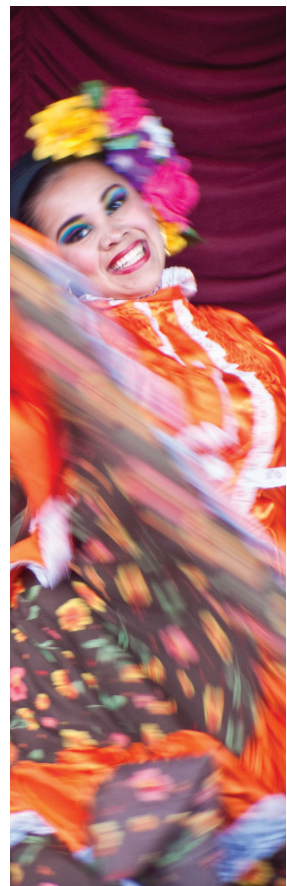

Nevada Arts Council

The Nevada Arts Council, a division of the Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs, was created as a state agency in 1967. Charged with supporting Nevada's arts and cultural sectors and expanding access to and public participation in the arts, the Nevada Arts Council (NAC) receives funding from the Nevada State Legislature, the National Endowment for the Arts and other private and public sources.

In partnership with schools, arts institutions and communities, NAC actively works to bring artists, a diversity of art forms and audiences together in Nevada's metropolitan centers and most isolated rural towns.

From folklife festivals to youth artwork projects, and concert series to visual arts exhibits, NAC's support of a breadth of public programs provides residents a rich quality of life—contributing to the health and diversity of Nevada's economy and workforce, increasing tourism, strengthening communities and fostering education through the arts.

THE ARTS IN NEVADA: AN ESSENTIAL PUBLIC VALUE

The Nevada Arts Council's investment in the state's creative industry provides residents a rich quality of life—contributing to the diversity of Nevada's economy, workforce and tourism, and fostering education through the arts.

Each year, the Nevada Arts Council builds on its collective knowledge, experiences and partnerships to better serve Nevadans, the creative industry and the overall prosperity of our state. Guided by *Values and Vision*, our five-year strategic plan, and committed to the core values of excellence, access, inclusion and integrity, the Nevada Arts Council balances its priorities to achieve statewide impact—from the individual to the institution.



The grants, programs and services provided by the Nevada Arts Council in FY2012, and identified in this draft Annual Report, speak to the enduring value of a very modest investment of public dollars in Nevada's creative industry.

The arts are celebrated throughout the Silver State—in small towns, rural areas, and in major metropolitan centers—sustaining individual curiosity, empowering group participatory experiences, benefiting local economies and providing critical educational opportunities.



THE NEVADA ARTS COUNCIL

A nine-member board appointed by the Governor promotes cultural policies and programs to benefit residents throughout the state and makes final decisions on Nevada Arts Council (NAC) grant allocations. Staff develops and administers programs that support the agency's mission and goals in accordance with the NAC strategic plan. A division in the Department of Tourism and Cultural Affairs, the NAC is divided into six program areas to serve our diverse population.

■ PROGRAMS

Nevada's wealth of professional artists—painters, dancers, musicians, filmmakers, actors, writers—are at the heart of quality arts and education programs, and vibrant communities across the state. The **Artist Services Program** provides resources for Nevada's creative workforce while promoting opportunities for artists to engage with citizens through highly valued outreach programs, such as the *Nevada Touring Initiative*.

Founded on the belief that the arts belong in the lifelong learning process of all citizens, the **Arts Education Program** provides school and community artist residencies, grants for innovative arts learning projects in- and out-of-school, professional development support for educators and statewide initiatives that enhance curriculum, such as *Poetry Out Loud*.

The **Community Arts Development Program** employs networking, planning grants and other services to help cities and towns across Nevada develop local strategies and programs that create and sustain community vitality. The *Nevada Circuit Riders* extends the NAC's reach by providing affordable consultancies to nonprofit arts and cultural organizations.

Nevada is rich with traditions and cultures. Honoring and working with a range of artists and communities—ethnic, tribal, regional, age, occupational, gender, religious and family—the **Folklife Program** documents Nevada's diverse cultural heritage to share with the public through publications, exhibitions, festivals, school programs, workshops and the *Nevada Folklife Archives*.

NAC is the primary source of public arts funding for Nevada's creative industry, schools and communities. The **Grants Program** supports hundreds of arts activities across the state each year. Even with significant agency cuts that have reduced NAC grants to often a small percentage of a grantee's total budget, the public investment of these dollars extends far beyond actual cash value—providing support to leverage new funds, encouraging innovative public/private partnerships and building local economies.

The **Public Awareness and Initiatives Program** facilitates statewide initiatives and collaborations to meet current needs and challenges of NAC constituencies and to promote the statewide creative industry, such as the online cultural calendar *Arts4Nevada.org*, strategic planning and the *Exploring Nevada* video series.



SNAPSHOTS FROM FY12

Reciting Poetry: A Rediscovered Pleasure: Thousands of Nevada high school-aged students have participated in the *Poetry Out Loud Program* and the experience will stay with them—like the poems they memorize and perform—for the rest of their lives. Generous support from NV Energy insured that the 2012 Nevada Poetry Out Loud remained a statewide program—engaging 74 schools, 101 teachers and more than 3,300 students. *Powering Up Poetry: Poets in Residence*—workshops for students in Battle Mountain, Virginia City, Elko, Carson City, Winnemucca and Hawthorne—were also presented by poets Shaun Griffin and Gailmarie Pahmeier.

Advancing Community: An exceptional group of Nevadans from 25 communities attended the *Fourth Annual Arts @ the Heart Convening*, held at Lake Tahoe in conjunction with the Commission on Tourism's Rural Round-up Conference. More than 100 representatives from local arts and community organizations, museums, tribal entities, chambers of commerce, economic development agencies and small businesses traveled from every corner of the state to connect and champion a vision that invests in people and the places they live.

On The Road: The highly acclaimed *Nevada Touring Initiative (NTI)*—the *Traveling Exhibition Program* and *Tumblewords*—connects audiences with the arts at the local level. NTI exhibits are professionally curated, and for a small fee, are delivered, installed and de-installed by the NAC in towns as small as Beatty to the Truckee Meadows suburbs. Artist talks and workshops to correspond with NTI exhibits are also offered. Professional poets and writers provide readings, workshops and lectures during a Tumblewords residency. In FY2012, 41,666 people attended 20 NTI visual arts exhibits, and 27 lectures and workshops by authors and artists in geographically isolated communities and urban neighborhoods in nine Nevada counties.

Honoring Traditions: Nevada's master folk and traditional artists are celebrated through the NAC's new online video series, *Nevada Stories*, an initiative of the Folklife Program. These artists are Nevada's tradition bearers—people who transmit what they believe, know, do and create with others who share a common heritage, language, religion, occupation or region. Their expressions are deeply rooted in and reflective of a community's shared standards of beauty, values or life experiences. Featured are Bill Maloy, saddle maker; Doug Groves, rawhide braider; and Mike Williams, Tule duck maker; as well as traditional dances of Thailand and Mexico; traditional Balalaika music and Taiko drumming; and traditions of the Washoe, Northern Paiute and Western Shoshone tribes.
