Festival Season

Spring and early summer means outdoor events galore in Northern Nevada.

RENO RIVER FESTIVAL MOVES TO JUNE

Changes for downtown Reno's annual whitewater kayaking event are in store for 2012 as the Reno River Festival announces the addition of former freestyle kayak world champion Ruth Gordon-Ebens as director. The ninth annual festival also makes a move to June 15-17, aiming for consistently warmer temperatures, while also adding two new sub-events: a Splash Dog Competition and the Biggest Little Dog Jog.

The Friday-through-Sunday festival includes the popular freestyle, boatercross, and slalom kayaking competitions, as well as the Run Amuck fun run on the 16th. Live music takes the stage throughout the weekend, along with Yoga in the Park and enough food and drink to satisfy any taste.

"We really took a close look at the event to determine what's working and what's not and moved forward from there," says festival owner Jim Bauserman. "Not only do we anticipate better, more consistent weather in June, we think that the new additions,

combined with the popular returning events, will be a welcome format."

The festival brings dogs to the park for the first time in 2012—as competitors—with Splash Dogs (splashdogs.com) and the Biggest Little Dog Jog. Splash Dogs is a nationally recognized dog-enthusiast company that organizes and promotes dock-jumping events across the United States. Preliminary rounds are held Friday and Saturday, followed by the finals on Sunday afternoon. Sunday's Biggest Little Dog Jog is a dog-owner fun run through downtown beginning at 11 a.m.

Only dogs that are registered participants are allowed in the park, and all dogs must be kept on a leash when not competing. ▀

ELVIS ROCKS MESQUITE

The third annual Elvis Rocks Mesquite event returns to the CasaBlanca Resort, June 21-23.

Fittingly, three days of singing Elvis Presley songs from the '50s, '60s, and '70s is capped by an Elvis look-alike (and sing-alike) competition. Johnny Fortuno of Henderson took gold last year, following up his blockbuster victory at the 2011 Ultimate Elvis competition on Fremont Street in Las Vegas. Fortuno's song selection included "All Shook Up" and "Heartbreak Hotel."

For his efforts, Fortuno pocketed \$3,000 in prize money to edge the talented Robert Washington, from Maine, who earned runner-up money of \$1,500.

As was the case in the inaugural Elvis Rocks Mesquite event, the second gathering of Elvis impersonators was so anticipated that the finale had fans lined up at the door long before the first Elvis song was sung. "I'm elated with the outcome of the event," said Sue Arko, an event promoter from Phoenix. "I think it certainly lived up to what people expected, especially when you tie in the related events." One of those events was a fundraiser to benefit tornado victims in the Midwest.

The combined efforts of all those involved to present a true showpiece was evidenced by the fans who traveled to the event. "I follow James King," said Sue Rivera, a Redondo Beach, Califor-

nia businesswoman. "I received a flier from one of the competitors, and I also belong to the Jail House Rockers in California. We are also connected with several Elvis Tribute Artists, so we follow the events.

"I had never been to Mesquite, and it's a pretty amazing place," Rivera continued. "This was my fifth time to see an Elvis competition, and this show was the best-produced contest that I have seen. The lighting and the showroom are fabulous." ▀
