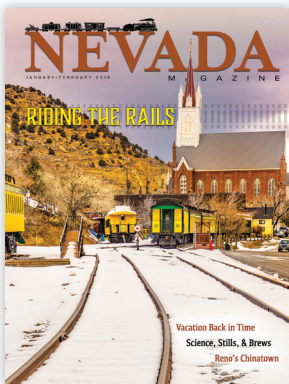

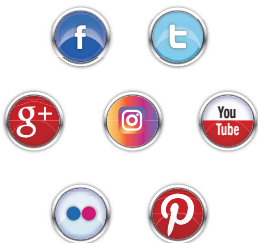

## SOAR TO THE CARSON VALLEY FOR A BIRD'S-EYE VIEW OF LOCAL WILDLIFE.

**E**agles & Agriculture, the Carson Valley's annual gathering of eagles and celebration of agriculture, celebrates its 16th year in 2018. The Jan. 25-28 event remains a combined effort of the Carson Valley Chamber of Commerce, UNR Cooperative Extension, The Nature Conservancy, Lahonton Audubon Society, and valley ranchers.

2018 begins with the welcome reception & photography exhibit on Thursday night, Jan. 25 in the Grandview Room of the Douglas County Community & Senior Center. The reception features an exhibition of the work of noted local wildlife photographers and a planned visit from several birds of prey.

On Friday, the tours begin with the popular trip to a wetlands area led by Jim Woods of Birding Under Nevada Skies. A variety of wildlife can be seen on this tour, which involves a medium hike over level ground. This tour is limited to 16, and participants should bring their scopes, binoculars, and cameras. This tour departs at 8 a.m. from the Carson Valley Inn.

On Friday evening, the Falconers' Dinner, which has

become a must-do event, takes place at the Carson Valley Inn. The dinner is a rare chance for people to get up close to falcons, hawks, owls, and other raptors for viewing and photographing these beautiful birds. The evening includes a three-course dinner, and there are exhibits throughout the Carson Valley Inn from businesses and organizations that support the Eagles & Agriculture efforts. There is also a raffle drawing that evening for prizes donated by exhibitors.

The weekend features many more tours and workshops designed to familiarize attendees with the wildlife of the region and how to photograph them.

## FIRST-TIMER'S GUIDE

### TIPS TO HELP YOU GET YOUR COWBOY ON, CORRECTLY.

Now in its 34th year, the National Cowboy Poetry Gathering (NCPG) in Elko has drawn cowpokes and urban cowboys alike to its lyrical blend of the Wild West, the spoken word, music, and more. Evolved from the earliest storytelling of the buckaroos who ranched and rode the western U.S., the art form has earned an international audience. This year's gathering takes place Jan. 29-Feb. 3.

But how do you "do" Cowboy Poetry? A glance at the program shows workshops in writing, gearmaking, cooking, and more; special sessions and discussions, exhibits of western art and gear; films about the West; lectures by prominent speakers; panel discussions of issues facing the rural West, open-mic sessions, ranch dances, and late-night jam sessions. Phew.

To assist, we reached out to some knowledgeable folks; Elko residents, attendees of multiple NCPGs, and others. Check out their tips to help you saddle up, and make your first gathering the best it can be.





## What about the weather?

Elko is in eastern Nevada. Translation: the daily high is just 37 degrees, so the chances of ice and snow are pretty good. Don Newman, executive director of the Elko Convention and Visitor's Authority, reminds visitors: "If it snows, although your new leather-sole cowboy boots will look great, slip-and-slide is the result and you look like a crazy dance is taking place."

Darcy Minter of the Western Folklife Center, agrees and notes that walking between some venues can be dicey in the winter weather. She recommends traction devices that slip over your shoes (she likes Yaktrax brand) to make sure you don't take a spill.

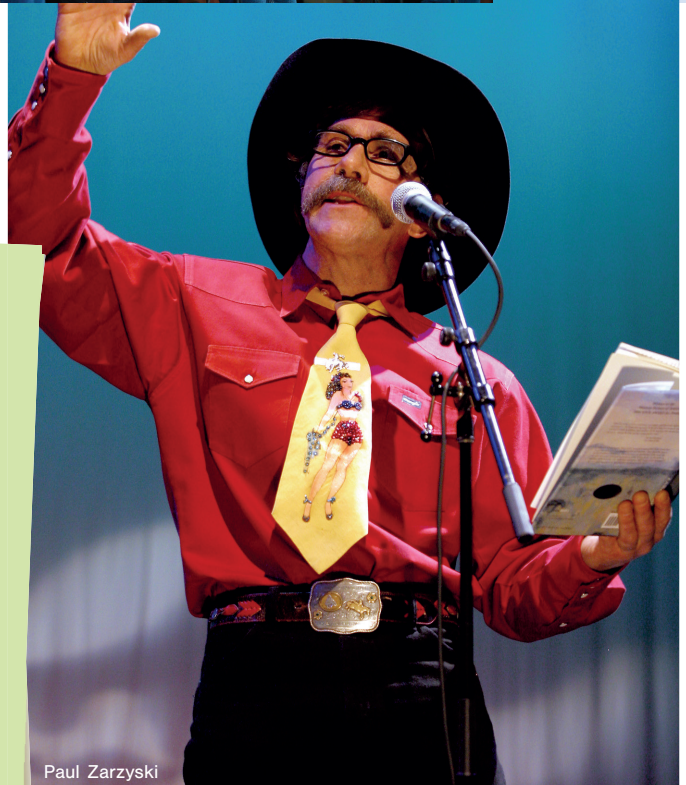

## Where should I eat?

The Star is renowned for Basque food (it's also Governor Brian Sandoval's favorite), but unless you're with a party of eight or more, seating may be tough. *The experts say...*

**Gretchen Ericson, 10-year attendee:**

- Use the shuttle bus; you never know who you might meet.
- Bring a seat cushion for events at Elko High or Flag View Middle schools. The seating at the high school is bleachers and the middle school seating is folding metal chairs.

## NEVADA STATE CAPITOL EXHIBIT UNDERGOES MAJOR RENOVATIONS.

**B**attle Born Hall, the museum exhibit inside the old Senate chambers on the second floor of the Nevada State Capitol, closed its doors Nov. 1, 2017 for a major renovation.

“We will be creating a new visitor experience,” Peter Barton, administrator of the Division of Museums and History, says.

“Doing so will require us to close down for 10 months or so to take out existing exhibits and build in the new experience.”

The Capitol building, which houses the offices of Gov. Brian Sandoval and other constitutional officers, will remain open during the construction and tours of the building conducted by docents from the Nevada State Museum will continue, including on Saturday.

Seattle-based Pacific Studio is creating the new exhibits, which will include the state’s prehistory, Native population, and early explorers; Nevada in the national context as the 36th state; and the state’s history of innovation.

“Visitors will find that Nevada has always been ahead of the curve on innovation,” Barton says. “From the way we constructed railroads to the way

we built mines to high-tech centers that store data or build energy systems for the future, Nevada has been and continues to be a leader.”

↳ The new exhibit will also focus on the room and

the Capitol building itself as the birthplace of Nevada’s government.

“When people go into Battle Born Hall, what we want them to understand is that room served as the Senate chambers for more than 100 years,” Barton says. “The debates that raged on in that room and across the hall in the old Assembly chambers, shaped what happened in the state. It’s real, it’s authentic and we want to share that with our visitors.”

The Nevada150 Foundation, which was formed to spearhead the state’s 150th birthday in 2014, dedicated \$700,000 for the Battle Born Hall renovation.

The exhibit is expected to open in the fall of 2018.

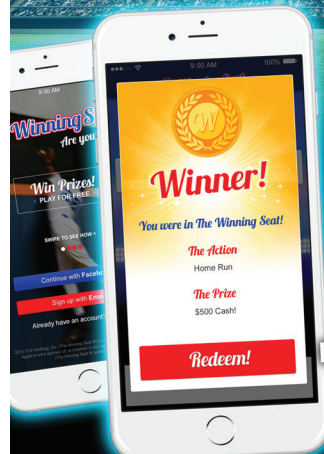

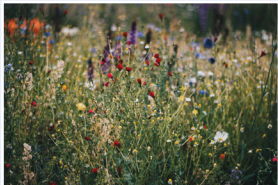

## OXGALLERY IN CARSON CITY WELCOMES LAS VEGAS ARTIST'S WORK.



Everywhere she has lived or studied, Las Vegas artist Andreana Donahue has incorporated physical pieces of the local environment into her work.

During a residency in Alaska, she used local wildflowers and berries she gathered in the summer months to create a dye for a quilt. When she had a residency in Corsicana, Texas, she used denim and mechanics' rags to create a remembrance quilt she titled "The Lone Star."

Originally from Chicago, Donahue is a visual artist, independent curator, and art handler. She has organized and exhibited in group and solo exhibitions in Alaska, Chicago, Los Angeles, Miami, South Carolina, New York, and Nevada.

In addition to her studio practice, Donahue has maintained the interdisciplinary advocacy project "Disparate Minds" with collaborator Tim Ortiz since 2014. The project includes curatorial projects, exhibition reviews, essays, and research dedicated to discussing the work of marginalized artists with disabilities in the context of contemporary art.

Her recent curatorial projects include group exhibitions at LAND in Brooklyn, New York, and The Good Luck Gallery in Los Angeles.

In her current exhibit, "Wintering Over," which opened at the OXS Gallery at the Nevada Arts Council in Carson City in November 2017, Donahue relates to the time she spent in residency in Iceland.

The exhibit remains in place until Jan. 12. An artist reception and talk by Donahue will be held Thursday, Jan. 11 from 5-7:30 p.m.

Managed by the Artist Services Program at the Nevada Arts Council, the gallery is located at 716 N. Carson St., Suite A, in Carson City. Hours are 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and admission is free.

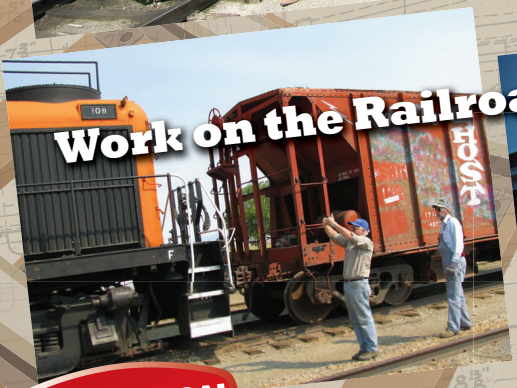

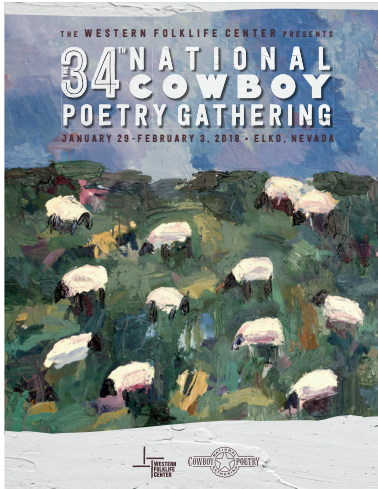
