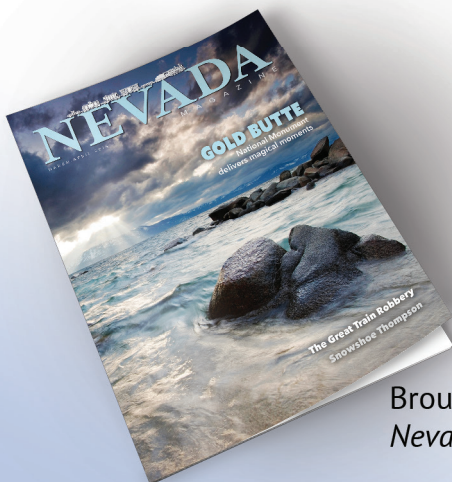

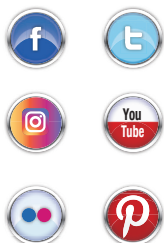

## ROCK FESTIVAL WELCOMES HEAVY-METAL HEAVYWEIGHTS TO DOWNTOWN.

**S**in City's premier rock and metal festival, Las Rageous, has released an updated performance lineup with the addition of hometown heroes, Otherwise, and goth-rock royalty, New Years Day. Coming to the Downtown Las Vegas Events Center for its highly anticipated second year on Friday, April 20 and Saturday, April 21, the Live Nation-created music festival takes over two square blocks in Downtown Las Vegas.

Otherwise and New Years Day join an already exciting lineup of both rock and metal icons and impressive newcomers. 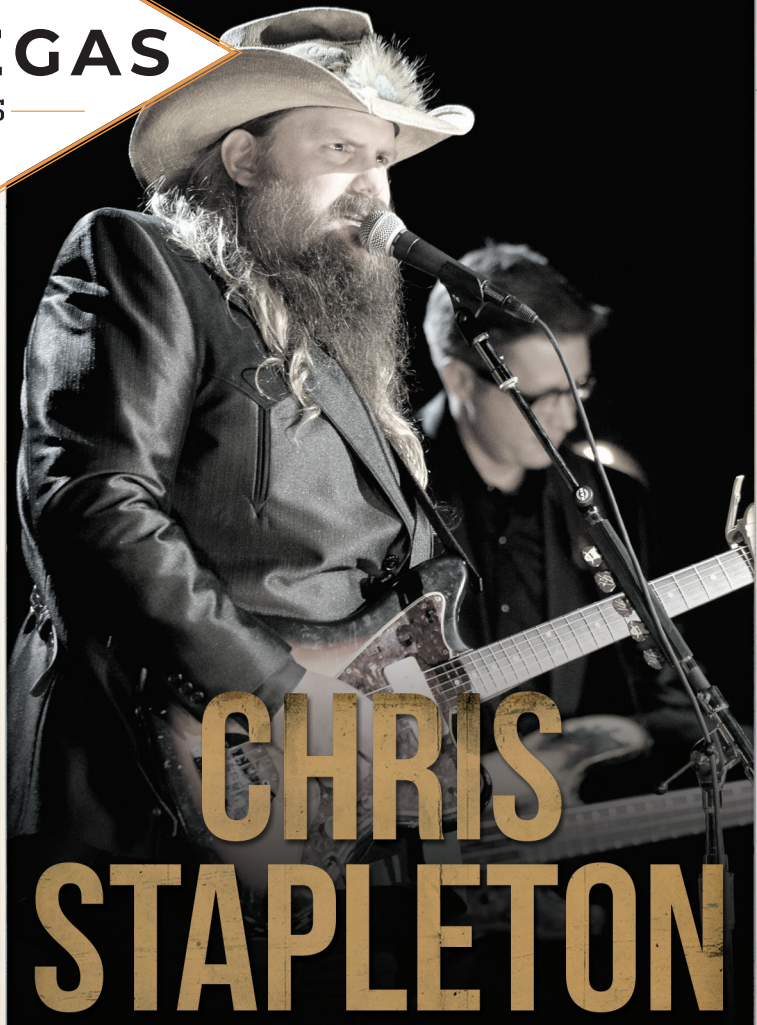

One of Nashville's most respected and beloved musicians, Chris Stapleton, performs at the MGM Grand Garden Arena in Las Vegas Friday, March 23. The multiple Grammy, Country Music Award (CMA), and Academy of Country Music (ACM) Award-winner is scheduled to take the stage at 8 p.m.

Following his breakthrough solo debut album "Traveller," Stapleton released two No. 1 albums in 2017: "From A Room: Volume 1" and "From A Room: Volume 2." Both albums take their name from legendary RCA Studio A where they were recorded with Grammy Award-winning producer

Dave Cobb. Released to overwhelming praise, the albums were featured on "Best of 2017" lists in "Rolling Stone," "Variety," "Stereogum," and "The Tennessean."

Stapleton was recently awarded Album of the Year (From A Room: Volume 1) and Male Vocalist of the Year at The 51st Annual CMA Awards. He recently won three 2018 Grammy Awards: Best Country Album (From A Room: Volume 1), Best Country Song ("Broken Halos"), and Best Country Solo Performance ("Either Way").

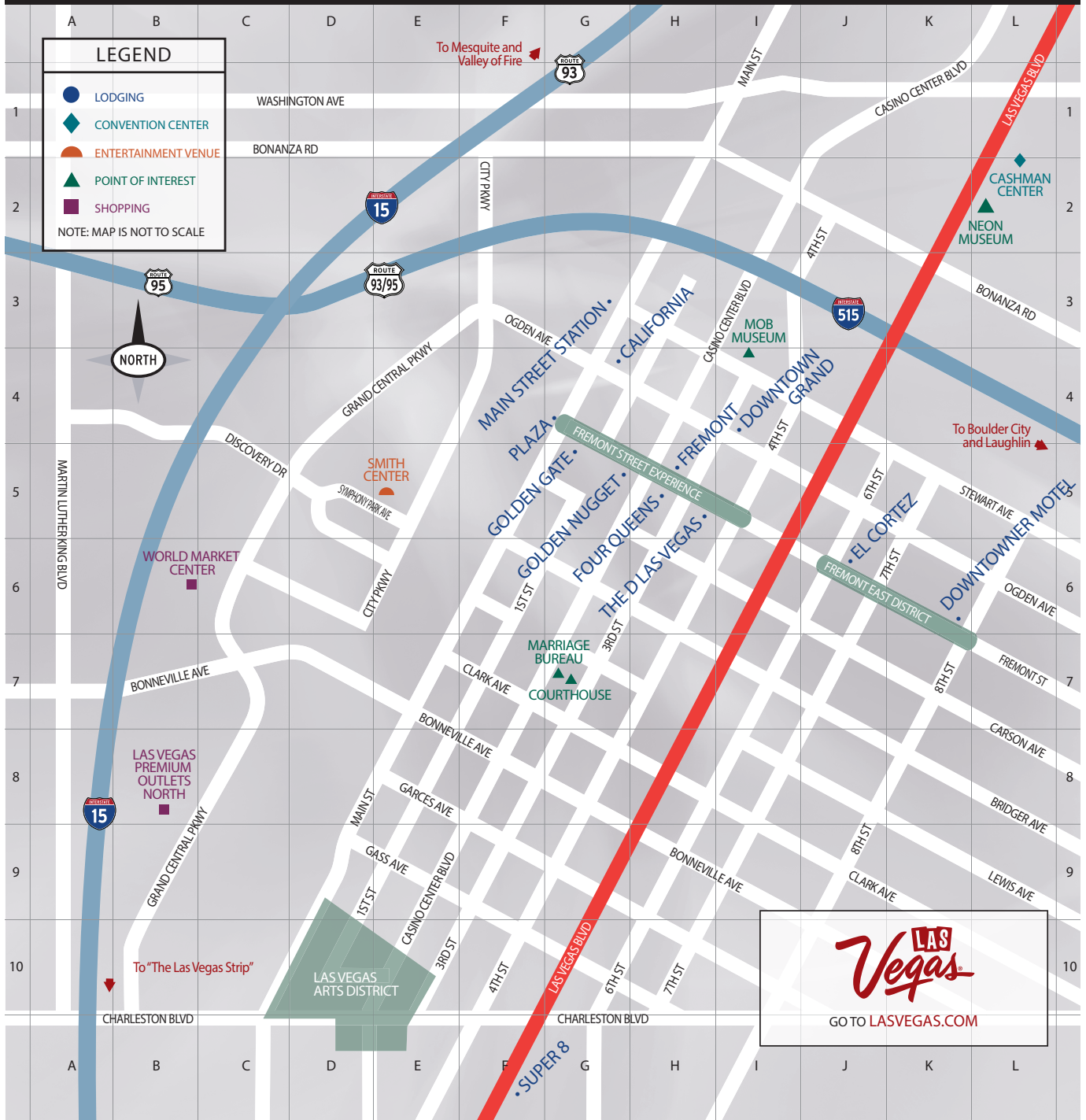

### TEAM UNVEILS 2018 REGULAR SEASON SCHEDULE.

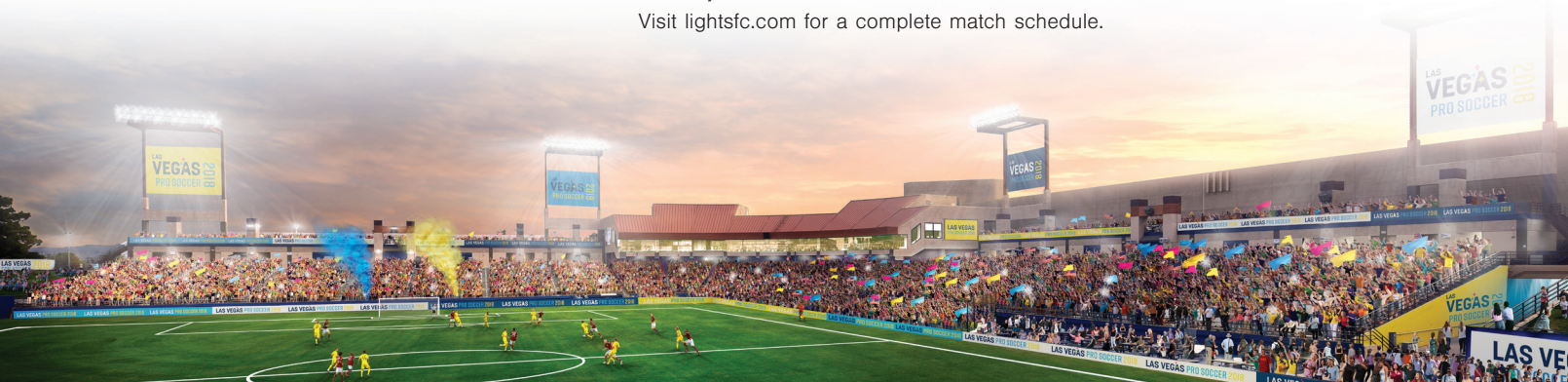
Of the 17 Las Vegas Lights Football Club (FC) regular season “soccer parties” the club is set to host at Cashman Field, 15 of those will be weekend matches with 8 p.m. start times.

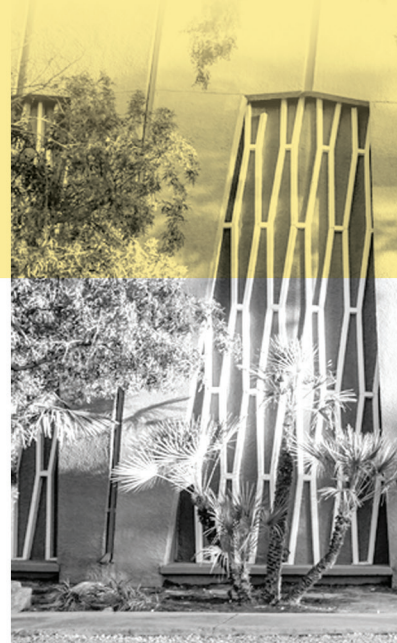

**T**he Nevada Preservation Foundation (NPF) has announced its 4th Annual Home + History Las Vegas event, April 27-29. The statewide foundation is expanding its offerings as it showcases southern Nevada's architectural past and how it is being preserved. This year, the foundation's highly anticipated Martini Tour Cocktail Party is being held in a southern Nevada luxurious 15,000-square-foot underground bomb shelter that features a putting green, pool, Jacuzzi, and its own casitas.

"We live in a state where residents don't realize there is a unique history behind our communities," says Heidi Swank, NPF Executive Director. "Our goal is to create programs and events that help showcase that history."

Over the past three years, interest in the event has increased in Nevada, as well as California, Arizona, and Utah with attendance increasing more than 50 percent each year.

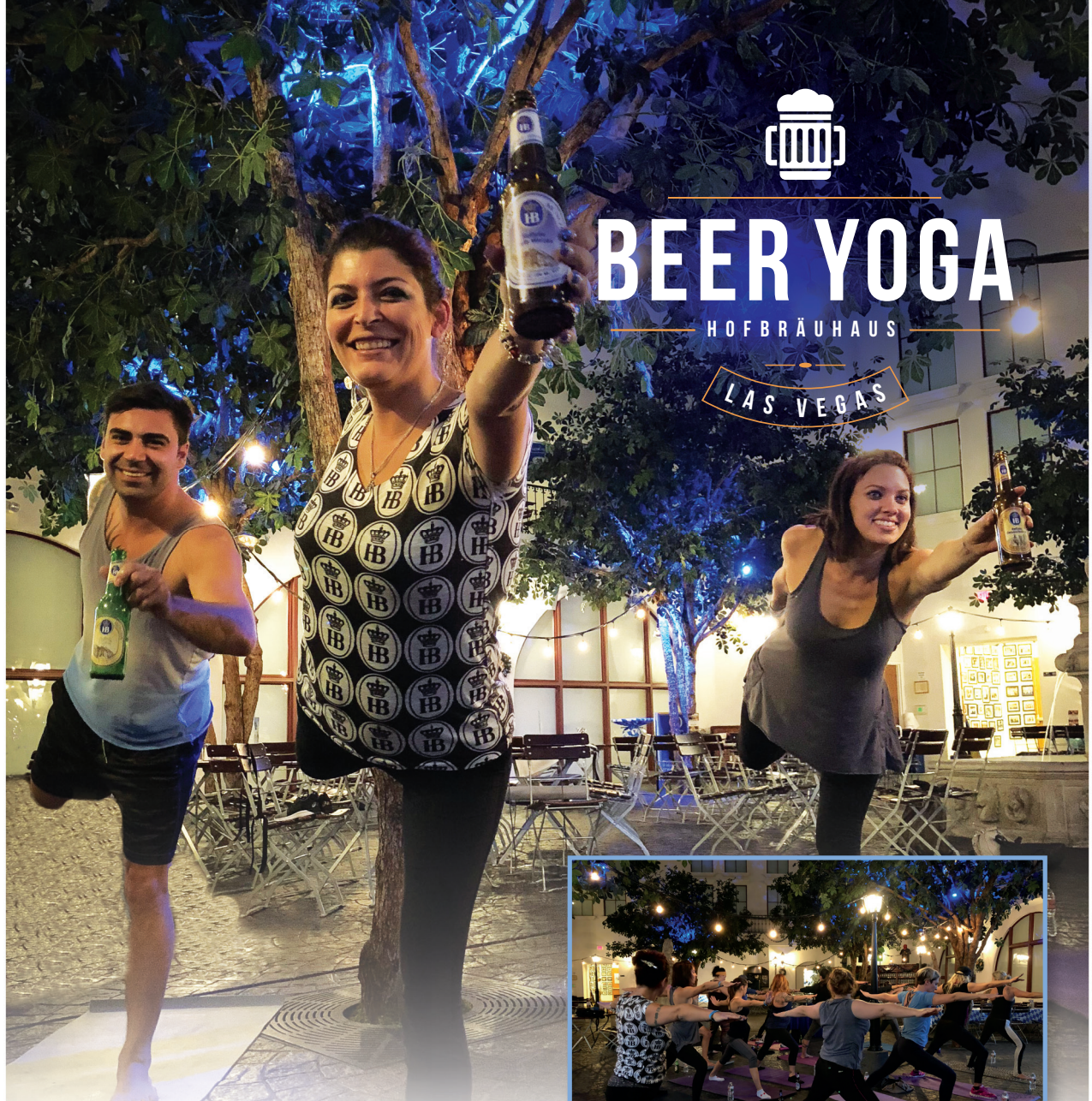

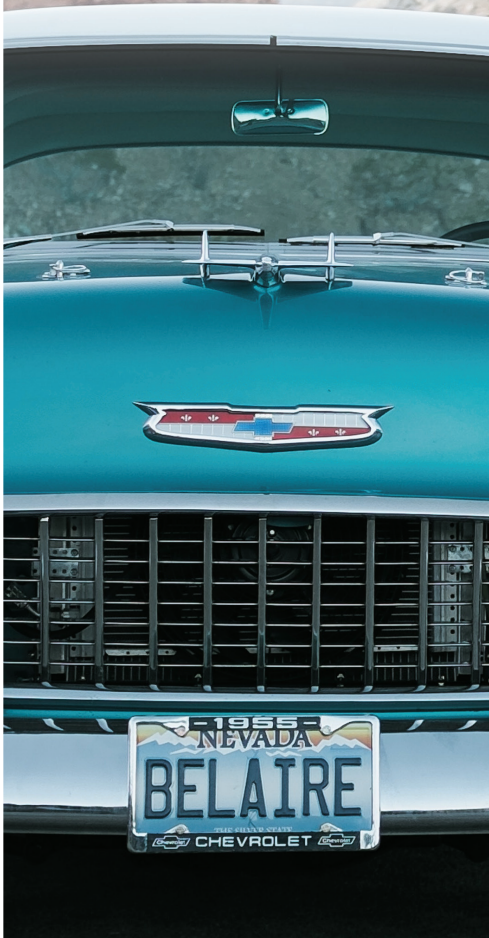

NUTTY FESTIVAL RETURNS TO VIRGINIA CITY ON ST. PATRICK'S DAY.



One of northern Nevada's first big events of the season takes place on St. Patrick's Day this year. The 27th annual Rocky Mountain Oyster Fry returns to historic Virginia City, Saturday, March 17 from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Each year, more than 7,000 people fill the streets to have some tasty testes prepared by more than a dozen cooks all competing to claim the winning title and bragging rights.

"We're all emerging from winter and people are ready to get out," Deny Dotson, tourism director for the Virginia City Tourism Commission, says. "This year, the event actually lands on St.

Patrick's Day, so we are getting ready to host one of the best celebrations around."

Since the event falls on March 17 this year, the Oyster Fry also includes Virginia City's St. Patrick's Day Parade, the Ball Breaker Saloon Crawl, a costume contest, and Irish music. For the first time this year, the parade begins at 10 a.m. Immediately following the parade, the green-striped C Street closes for the remainder of the day.

During the Oyster Fry, cooks compete in a balls-out competition serving fried, chopped, grilled, or sautéed beef testicles all while making you forget what you're eating. More than \$2,500 in prizes are given to the Best Overall Professional, Best Overall Amateur, Best Presentation, Most Creative Dish, and People's Choice.

Tasting tickets start at \$7 for three samples or 10 samples for \$15. New this year are the "Very Important Baller" (VIB) ticket options which grant front of line access and are the fast pass to showing friends how brave you really are.

After more than a year of nonoperation, visitors to the Nevada State Museum in Carson City can watch the museum's historic Coin Press No. 1 carry on a mission it started nearly 150 year ago in the very same building.

The venerable press—which churned out millions of dollars in silver and gold coins during stints at U.S. Mints in Carson City, Philadelphia, San Francisco, and Denver between 1870 and 1964—is once again minting medallions after being down for much of 2017 for repairs.

After a successful test run in December 2017, the museum plans to have the press operational the last Friday of each month, with two-person teams of volunteers not only working the press, but sharing its history with museum visitors. The demonstrations take place from 9 a.m. to noon and from 1-4 p.m.

“We are delighted to, once again, offer demonstrations that allow visitors to see it in action producing medallions with the famous ‘CC’ mint mark, and have that rare personal moment with a Nevada history legend,” Myron Freedman, director of the Nevada State Museum, says. “The coin press is one of

the museum's most beloved artifacts and the staff and volunteers love sharing its history. The fact that it is operating in the same Mint building where it first began service makes it one of the most unique coin presses in the world.”

Manufactured by Morgan & Orr in Philadelphia, the six-ton press arrived in Carson City in 1869 and pressed its first coin—a seated Liberty dollar—on Feb. 11, 1870.

Between 1870 and 1893, the Carson City Mint produced nearly \$50 million (face value) of gold and silver coins, including gold double eagles (\$20) and eagles (\$10), half eagles (\$5), silver dollars, half dollars, quarters, dimes and 20-cent pieces.

Today, coins with the CC Mint mark are highly prized by collectors and among the most valuable in the collecting world.

The coin press demonstrations are free to observe with museum admission. Patrons can also purchase a blank .999 silver medallion at the museum store for \$60 and see it pressed with one of the special designs.

It's likely that you'll hear it before you see it. The pop of a jet compressor, shooting water more than 40 feet into the sky, the splash of it crashing back down into the basin below, or the sound of classical music as part of a special water show. Then you see it: the water weaving and swaying, programmed to move in time with music; the fountains lit up and glowing from colorful LEDs; and a crowd of people filming the entire show. It's all part of Atlantis Casino Resort Spa's reimagined water fountains, which were recently unveiled after four months of work.

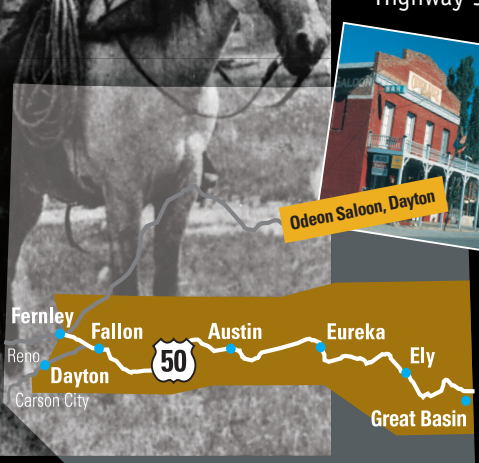

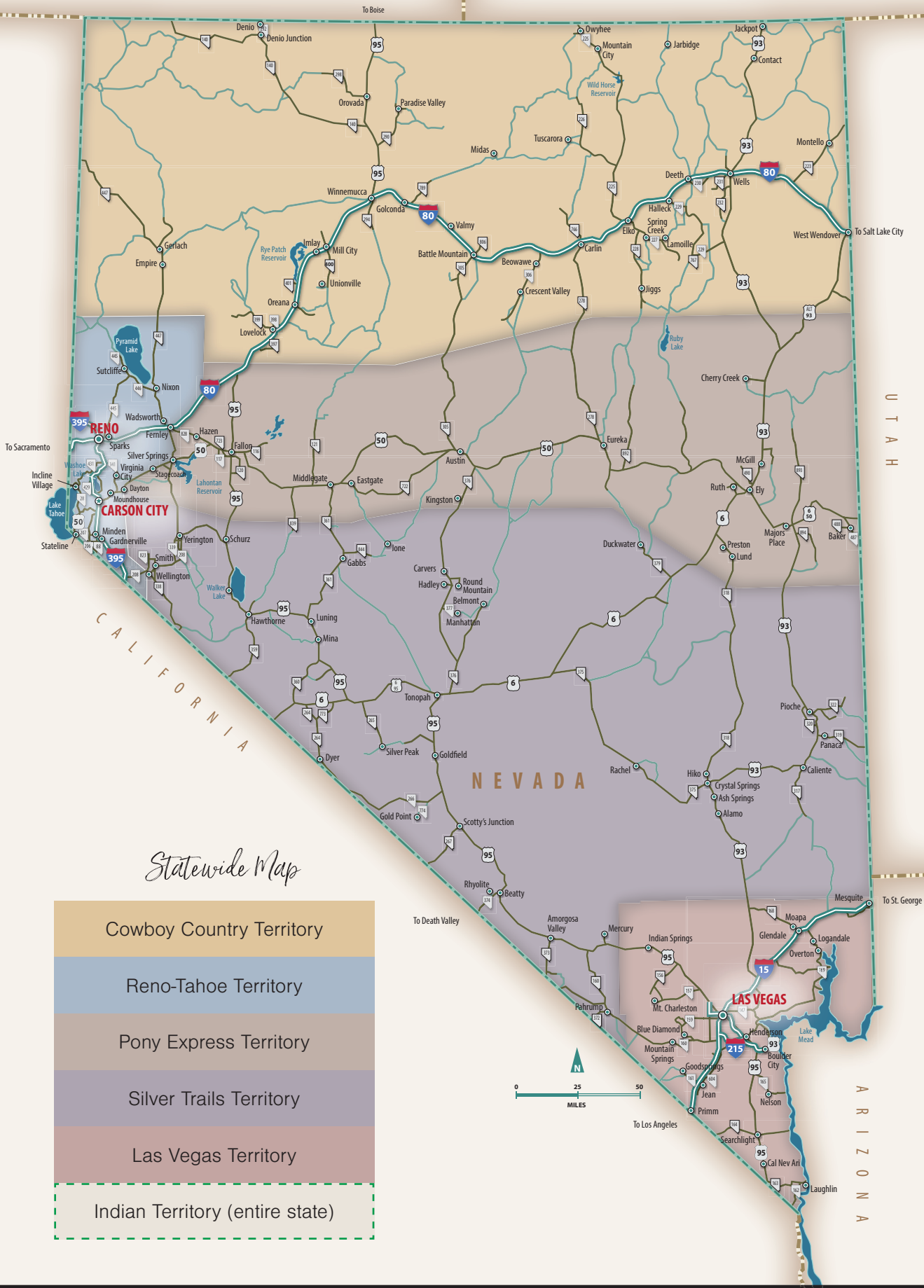

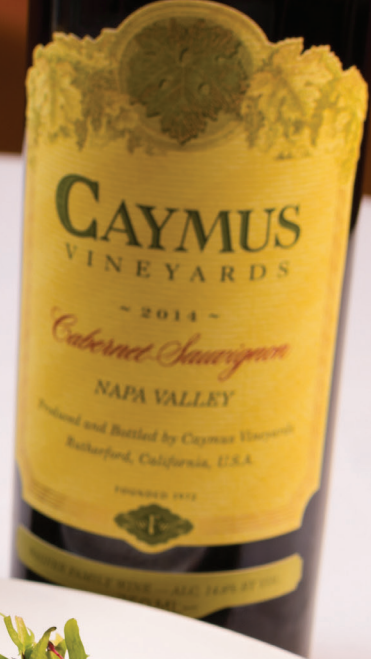
