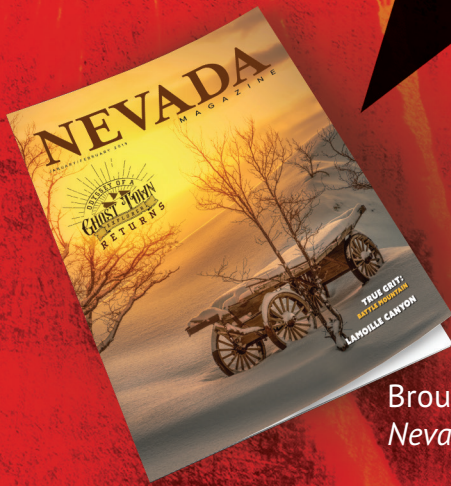

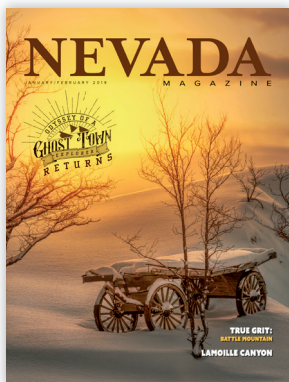

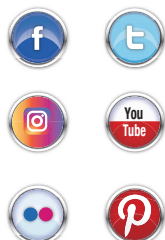

Following overwhelming success of 18 “Strait to Vegas” shows, the superstar known worldwide as “The King of Country” George Strait returns to T-Mobile Arena in Las Vegas with special guest Ashley McBryde for two shows on Feb. 1-2.

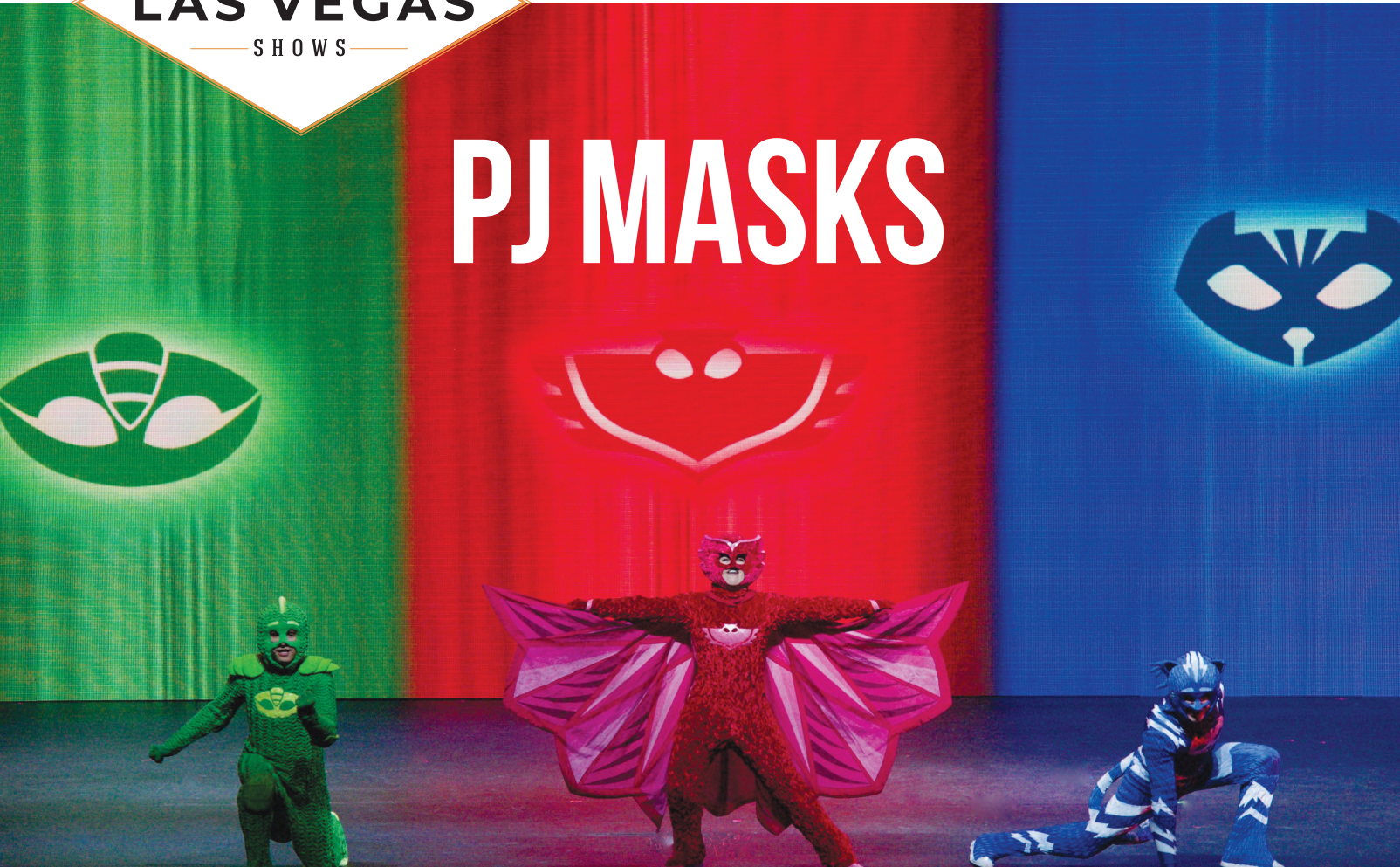

After an epic and storied 45-year career that launched an era of rock 'n' roll legends, KISS announced that the band is launching its final tour ever in 2019, appropriately named "End of the Road." The initial announcement was made in 2018 on NBC's "America's Got Talent," which sent the internet into overdrive with fans hoping their city would get one final KISS show. The tour makes a Las Vegas stop at T-Mobile Arena Friday, Feb. 15 at 7 p.m.

THRICE JOINS ROCK BAND ON THE ROAD, WITH A STOP AT THE JOINT.

Bring Me the Horizon announced southern California rock band Thrice is joining them as support on all dates of their North American 16-city 'First Love' Tour. The tour makes a stop at The Joint at Hard Rock Hotel & Casino Las Vegas on Saturday, Feb. 16 at 7 p.m.

In 2016, Thrice released its hit album "To Be Everywhere Is to Be Nowhere" (via Vagrant Records). Featuring frontman Dustin Kensrue, guitarist Teppei Teranishi, bassist Eddie Breckenridge, and drummer Riley Breckenridge, the band stepped into the spotlight with the 2000 album "Identity Crisis." With later releases including the 2003 breakout "The Artist in the Ambulance" and a duo of concept LPs (2007

& 2008's "The Alchemy Index: Fire and Water and Earth and Air"), Thrice took a several-year hiatus starting in 2012. Arriving in May 2016, "To Be Everywhere Is to Be Nowhere" proved to be Thrice's most politically minded yet vulnerable work to date. The band's newest album "Palms" was released this year on Epitaph Records.

Los Angeles trio FEVER 333 also joins the tour as support on all dates. Known for its hard-hitting hybrid of hip-hop, punk, and activism, the band recently released a video for the remix of its track "Made An America," featuring Travis Barker and Vic Mensa.

'BEASTLY FASHION'



NEW EXHIBITION FEATURES DESIGN ELEMENTS CREATED FROM ANIMAL LIFE.

“**B**eastly Fashion”—a new exhibition at the Nevada State Museum, Las Vegas—offers a historical look at fashion accessories, which feature design elements created from animal life.

The historical items that make up the collection come from the museum’s costume and textile collection and includes artifacts that, when examined through a contemporary lens, might not meet modern acceptable standards. In the earlier era in which these items were created, however, such materials and usage were agreeable and common in popular culture.

One such item is a top-handled handbag constructed from alligator skin that includes parts of the animal’s body. Possibly considered macabre today, this

style bag was popular in the 1950s, and was available in the Sears and Roebuck Catalog, which touted a Cuban-made version as “a fashion conversation piece.” They were also staples in the mid-century Cuban tourist trade and were often sold at souvenir stands in southern Florida.

The museum preserves such applications of animal products to illustrate and educate the community concerning both the history of fashion and the evolution of societal standards.

The “Beastly Fashion” exhibit is on display in the Nevada State Museum’s Curators Canyon Gallery through March 2019.

The World Financial Group Continental Cup of Curling returns to the Orleans Arena Jan. 17-20. This curling event pits six of the top men's and women's teams from North America up against six of the best from the rest of the curling world. Several disciplines, including the new mixed-doubles event, are contested over a four-day period. Participants include Olympic champions, world

champions, and more.

Curling is a sport in which competitors slide heavy granite stones on an ice surface toward a target area. Curlers use brooms to manipulate the ice and either speed up or slow down the stone, attempting to get it as close to the center of the bull's eye as possible. Curling has been a medal sport in the Winter Olympics since 1998.

SHARP-DRESSED MEN BRING CLASSIC HITS TO LAS VEGAS.

Following a wildly successful sold-out five-show run in April 2018, ZZ Top announced its return to The Venetian Theatre inside The Venetian Las Vegas for an eight-show limited engagement in 2019. The show is held on Jan. 18-19, 23, 25-26 and 30, and Feb. 1-2.

ZZ Top, also known as “That Little Ol’ Band From Texas,” lays undisputed claim to being the longest running major rock band with original personnel intact and, in 2004, the Texas trio was inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. There are only three of them—Billy F Gibbons, Dusty Hill, Frank Beard—but it’s still a remark-

able achievement that they’re still very much together after almost 50 years of rock, blues, and boogie on the road and in the studio.

As a touring unit, ZZ Top has been without peer over the years. The band has performed before millions of fans through North America on numerous tours, as well as overseas where they enthralled audiences from Slovenia to Argentina, Australia to Sweden, Russia to Japan, and most points in between. The band’s iconography—beards, cars, girls, and that magic keychain—seems to transcend all bounds of geography and language.

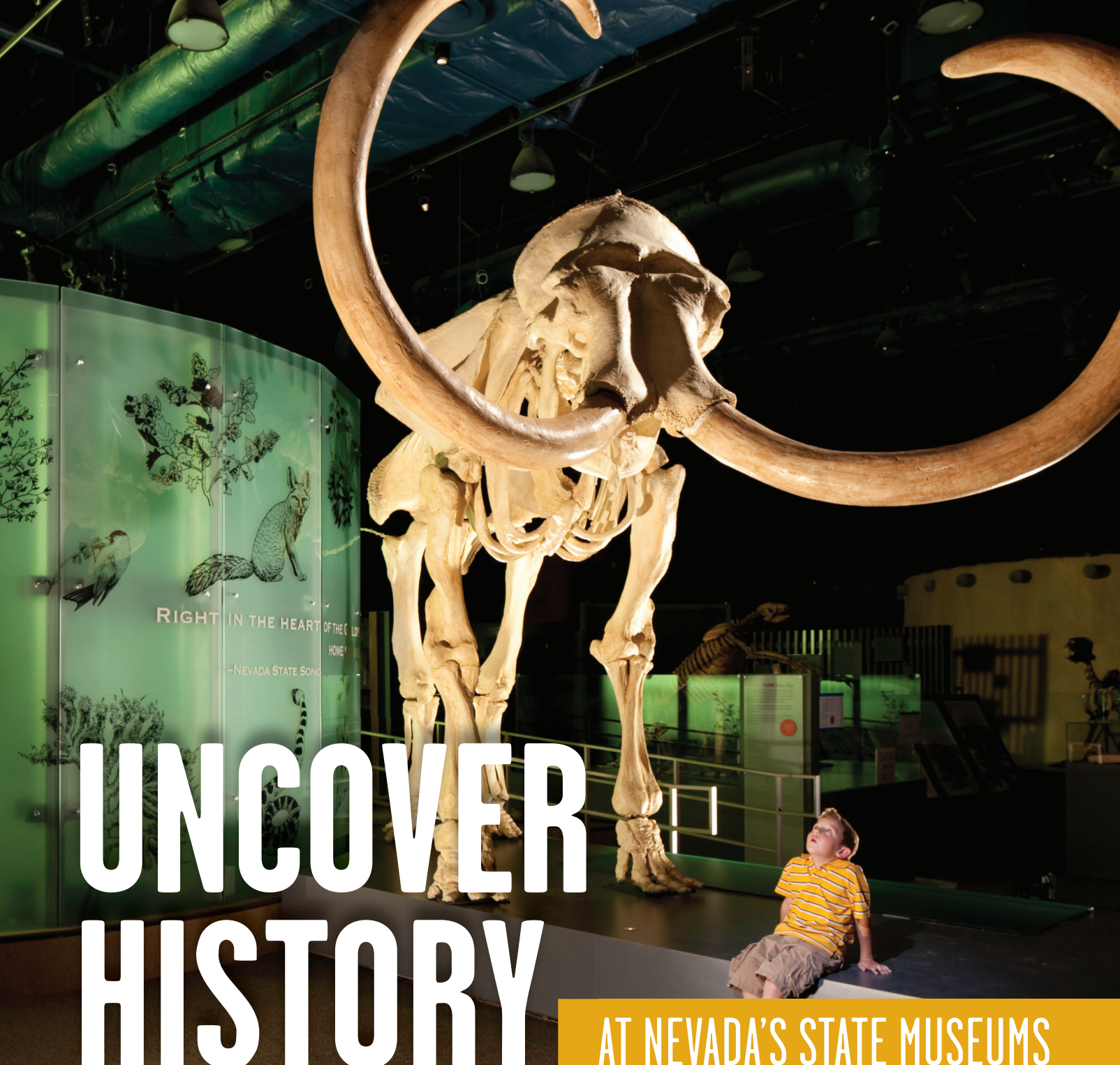

RAZOR/WIRE

Nevada Humanities presents “Razor Wire,” an exhibition curated by Shaun T. Griffin at the Nevada Humanities Program Gallery in Las Vegas. This exhibition, which opened December 2018 and is on display through Jan. 23, features recent art and poetry from the Razor Wire Poetry Workshop held at the Northern Nevada Correctional Center in Carson City and is part of the Nevada Humanities Exhibition Series. The Razor Wire Poetry Workshop is led by Griffin and offered to incarcerated men who learn to articulate their life experiences through creating poetry and art. The exhibition features works in a variety of mediums, including acrylic painting, pen, ink drawings, pastel drawings, and many poems from the last few years of the workshop. The new issue of “Razor Wire,” the journal produced periodically from the art and poetry created in the workshop, will also be featured. Current and past issues of the “Razor Wire” journal are available at the Nevada Humanities Program Gallery.

Griffin, Nevada poet, editor, and community leader states, “I started this workshop in 1989, and it is the primary artistic outlet on the yard. Since its inception, more than 150 men have participated, and to my knowledge, only two have returned to prison, albeit briefly, for minor parole violations. That is fairly remarkable on a yard where the recidivism rate is frequently over 50 percent.” Griffin adds that he hopes that the Razor Wire exhibition will inspire his students to keep writing. “Outside of the workshop their lives spiral to small things—walking, sleeping, eating—but having an identity beyond the yard, especially that of being an artist, is lifesaving. These kinds of exhibitions let the men know they have value and by inference, their art does too.”

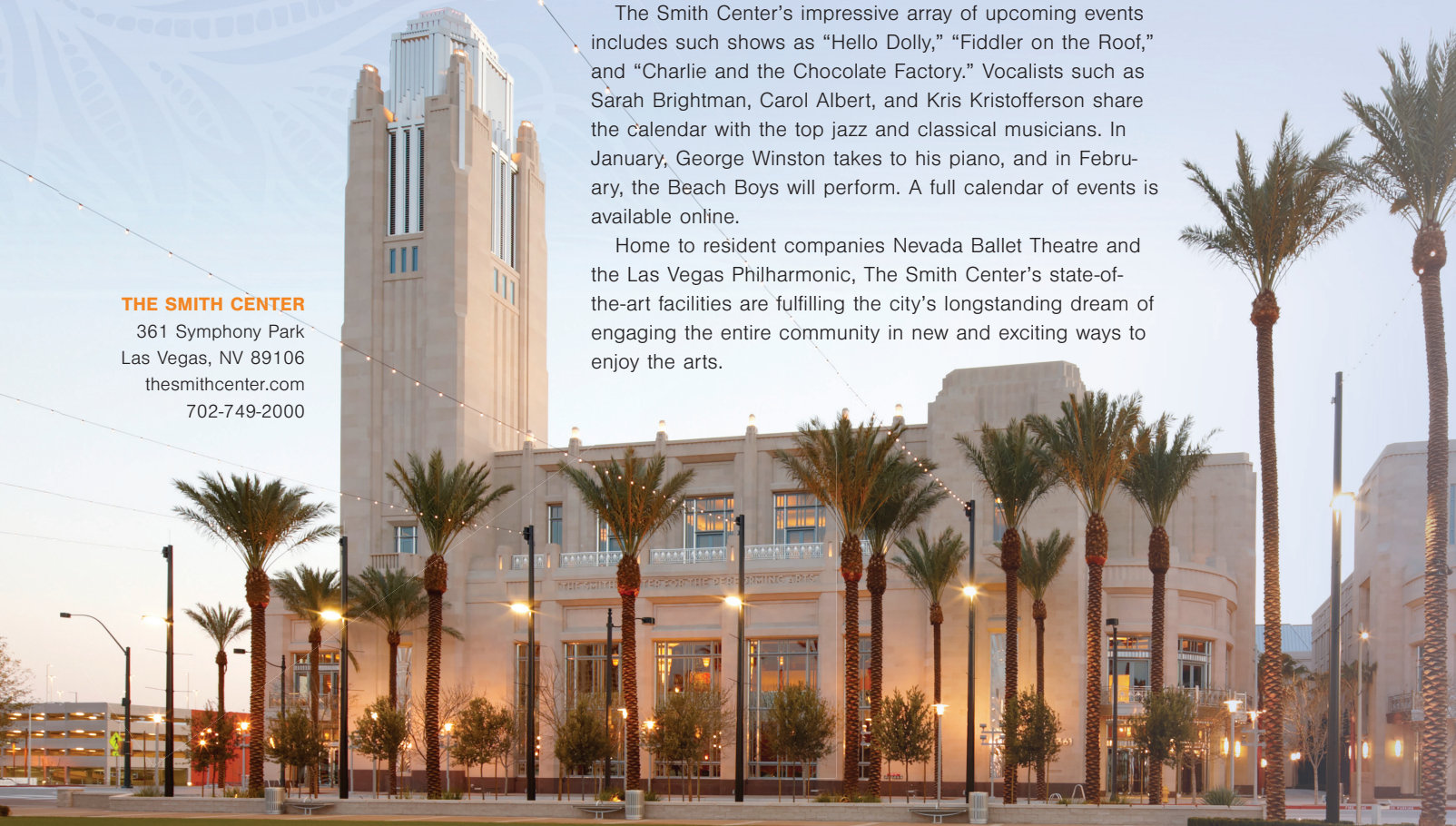

HIDDEN CAVE AT GRIMES POINT

Grimes Point, Hidden Cave, and other exposed caves—located just 10 miles east of Fallon in Northern Nevada—reveal the archeological story of the area’s American Indians. The petroglyphs at Grimes Point are a historical textbook that offers an easy self-guided tour among the rock art. These carvings can be seen while hiking an easy 1-mile loop. Setting off from the parking lot, the trail is best hiked in a counter clockwise direction.



KIPPY S. SPILKER

Hidden Cave—formed some 21,000 years ago—is an underground peek at how the American Indians used this formation to store food and implements. In 1927, four boys looking for bandit gold stumbled onto the cave, however the first archaeological excursion to the cave wasn’t until 1940. Since then, the cave has had two other excavations where artifacts have been discovered. On the second and fourth Saturday of each month (except federal holiday weekends) free public tours of the cave are given. The tours start at the Churchill County Museum. It’s a 15-minute hike up the trail to the cave, so be prepared.

THE CHURCHILL COUNTY MUSEUM

The Churchill County Museum and Archives is one of the finest small museums in the western United States. It has more than 20,000 square feet of exhibits, artifacts, and detailed displays including permanent history displays and traveling exhibits. The museum showcases the lifestyles of American Indians who inhabited the area thousands of years ago. The

tule duck and baskets exhibits are spectacular examples of the craft of weaving, and the travails of pioneers through the Forty-Mile Desert are presented through an audio interpretation and a display of relics found there.
