

Introduction

2006 Trophy Fish Program

The Nevada Department of Wildlife received 131 Trophy Fish entries in 2006 including one new state record:

- David Lorain from Winnemucca captured a 3-pound 1-ounce 16.1-inch white crappie from Rye Patch Reservoir on June 17, 2006. The previous state record of 2-pounds 13-ounces was from Weber Reservoir in 2000.

In addition to the one new state record, eight new water records were established:

Twenty-seven (27%) of the 131 entries were for coldwater fish: trout and mountain whitefish. Mackinaw trout contributed the most entries at 12, followed by brown trout at 10 entries and rainbow trout at nine. All the mackinaw were captured at Lake Tahoe. Ruby Lake NWR, Comins Lake, and Knott Creek Reservoir continue to produce trophy rainbow trout. The brown trout were caught out of Lake Tahoe, the Truckee River and Ruby Lake NWR. The four Lahontan cutthroat trout were, of course, from Pyramid Lake.

The 95 warmwater entries made up 73 percent of the total trophy fish entries. Walleye led the list with an unprecedented 58 entries – all were captured from Rye Patch Reservoir or the Humboldt River just downstream of the reservoir. Wipers and smallmouth bass were number two in entries with seven each. All wipers were captured from the Humboldt River below Rye Patch. The smallmouth bass were captured from Barth Pit, South Fork Reservoir and Lake Mead. Channel catfish entries were number four in entries with four total, three from South Fork Reservoir and one from the Humboldt River. The three largemouth bass entries were scattered around the state: Redhead Pond (Mason Valley WMA), Squaw Creek Reservoir and Haymeadow Reservoir (Kirch WMA).

Nevada is presently in a dry cycle following two consecutive years of above average precipitation. This translates out to less water, but concentrated fish. So don't let the low water deter you; head to a lake or reservoir in your area and catch those fish that have been growing for the past two years. Even if you aren't able to break a state record, there's always the chance of a new water record.

THE CONTEST

People love competition. Whether it's bowling, racquetball or fishing, a good contest between friends always makes any activity a little more exciting and gives it that certain edge. Kevin Peterson and Kent Burroughs are no exception. Friends since first meeting at an NBU (Nevada Bighorns Unlimited) function. Kevin wanted to know who that "fool" was that fished all night – that "fool" was Kent. They have hunted sheep and chukar together, but last year their fishing competition really heated up with a walleye, wiper contest in the Humboldt River downstream of Rye Patch Reservoir. During the heat of the competition, Kent contacted the Fisheries' administrative assistant and attempted to talk her into sending his, Kent's, Trophy Fish certificates to Kevin by "mistake." This wasn't the first time the friends have played tricks on each other. Winter before last, Kent got his truck stuck at Stampede Reservoir and had to leave it. Upon learning of Kent's predicament, Kevin forged a letter to Kent, allegedly from the Forest Service, stating that they were charging Kent \$30 per day for storage. Kent bit, so to speak, and telephoned the Forest Service in a state of worry and unhappiness.

At the end of the 2006 fishing season Kent had entries into NDOW for 17 walleye and 2 wipers - walleye have to be a minimum of 6 pounds and wipers a minimum of 5 pounds. Kent had the largest walleye at 12 pounds even, which also was the largest walleye captured in 2006. Kevin topped out at 21 walleye and 4 wiper entries and the largest wiper, a 17-pound 12-ounce beauty that was 27 and $\frac{3}{4}$ inches in length. Kevin's wife, Amy Jo, not to be outdone, had three walleye that received Trophy Certificates. Kevin's daughter, Lindsay, managed to land one walleye and one carp that received Trophy certificates. Her carp, at 9-pounds 1-ounce, set a new water record for the Humboldt River.


We at the Nevada Department of Wildlife have declared the contest an official tie and wonder what you guys will be competing for in 2007.






