INDIAN WAR CLAIMS.

The Legislature of 1887 re-enacted the law of 1885, which created a Board for the purpose of inquiring into and passing upon all claims against the State of Nevada, by persons who rendered services, expended money or incurred indebtedness, or furnished supplies between the first day of January, 1860, and the eighth day of February, 1887. This Board consisted of the Governor, Secretary of State and Attorney-General. In the performance of this duty the Board gave careful attention to the consideration of various claims, and expended much time in hearing and digesting the testimony relative to each claim presented before it. In addition to the labor thus performed, as a member of said Board, the Secretary of State and his Deputy have conducted a large correspondence, bearing on these claims, which was necessitated by the material witnesses, in many valid claims, being at distant points, and, in some cases, difficult of access. But the labor was finally ended and the claims, as allowed, in the following table, forwarded to Senator Stewart in Washington, where, with those passed two years ago, they will be pressed for payment during the next session of Congress :
