




## TGE Sector Jobs

- Jobs in Nevada's tourism/gaming/entertainment sector totaled 377,551 in 2011, up from 353,919 in 2001. This was a 6.7% increase, above the national gain of 6.1%. Average earnings per job in 2011 was \$30,951, which was above the national average of \$22,372.
- There were 10,153 TGE establishments in Nevada in 2011. Establishments are businesses that have a physical location in the State. These are not necessarily headquarters, but local offices (our outlets).
- Food services and drinking places had the largest increase, from 66,390 jobs in 2001 to 100,040 jobs in 2011. The largest TGE industry is accommodations, which includes casino hotels, with 194,420 jobs in 2011, a decrease from 210,545 jobs in 2001.
- The sector has shown signs of recovery, as visitor volume has been on the increase for over two years in Las Vegas.
