




Teen Employment In Nevada

Employment: 14-18 Year Olds



- The Local Employment Dynamics (LED) Program is a cooperative partnership between states and the Census Bureau. The Program creatively integrates existing data from state-supplied administrative records on workers and employers with existing censuses, surveys, and other administrative records. This allows, amongst other things, for the generation of information about trends in employment, hiring, job creation and destruction, and earnings across geographies and demographic groups.
- LED employment data suggest that Nevada teens (14-18 years old) were hit very hard by the recession.
- Employment levels (based upon official wage records) have essentially been cut in half...from a pre-recession peak of more than 46,000 to just above 20,000 (as of mid-2011, the most recent data available).
