




Unemployment Rates In Nevada

County Unemployment Rates (Year-to-Date, Not Seasonally Adjusted)



- County unemployment rates vary widely, with the lowest in rural counties and highest in so called "bedroom communities," outside of metro areas. All counties but two have seen jobless rates decline from 2011 levels. Statewide, the unemployment rates averaged 12% during the first half of the year, down from 13.7% a year ago.
- Rural counties have benefitted from a healthy mining sector.
- The lowest unemployment rates are in Lander (5.7%), Esmeralda (6.1%) and Eureka (6.2%).
- The highest unemployment rates are in Lyon (16%) and Nye (14.8%).
