




U.S. 2020 Educational Level



•Based on the 2010-2020 Long-Term Occupational Projections, the educational levels required for occupations projected through 2020 in Nevada are similar to the national trend in three out of the eight categories.

•The share of Nevada's anticipated workforce accounted for by those occupations requiring an associate's degree, some post-secondary education (non-degree program), or some college (but no degree) is equal to the national norms.

Nevada 2020 Educational Level



•Noticeable differences are in those occupations requiring just a high school diploma (45% in Nevada vs. 40% in the nation), less than high school education (33% in Nevada vs. 29% in the nation) and a bachelor's degree (10% in Nevada vs. 16% in the nation).
