

New Hires Earn Highest Monthly Wage in Eureka/Lander/Humboldt (Average New Hire Wages by County; Local Employment Dynamics Data)



- The Local Employment Dynamics (LED) Partnership is a voluntary federal-state partnership that was started in 1999. Its main purpose is to merge data from workers with data from employers to produce a collection of enhanced labor market statistics known collectively as Quarterly Workforce Indicators (QWI), subject to strict protection of the identity and confidentiality of the individual respondents.
- The statewide new hire wage is \$2,400 per month, on average.
- Average new hire wages range from \$1,500 per month (Lincoln) to \$7,000 per month (Eureka). The substantial starting wage in Eureka County can be attributed to a high concentration of gold mining industry jobs.
- Newly hired workers in Clark, Washoe, and Carson City earn slightly less on average than the State as a whole, at \$2,400, \$2,350, and \$2,300 per month on average respectively.
