



# GOLF GALA

SOUTHERN NEVADA ROLLS OUT A NUMBER OF GOLF-THEMED EVENTS AND ATTRACTIONS.

## MICHAEL JORDAN CELEBRITY INVITATIONAL

The annual Michael Jordan Celebrity Invitational (MJCI), hosted by ARIA Resort & Casino at Shadow Creek, returns to Las Vegas for the second consecutive year, March 29-April 1. One of celebrity golf's most popular events gives fans the opportunity to watch four days of competition with some of the biggest names in sports and entertainment.

Since its inception in 2001, the tournament has raised nearly \$6 million for charities including Make-A-Wish Foundation, Nevada Cancer Institute, James R. Jordan Foundation, and Cats Care, the Charlotte Bobcats' charity arm.

This year's MJCI is scheduled to kick off Wednesday, March 28 at ARIA with a welcome reception presented by Jordan Brand. The first of two rounds of the Celebrity-Amateur tournament, which pairs one celebrity with four amateur participants, will take place Thursday, March 29 at Shadow Creek. The final round of the Celebrity-Amateur will take place Friday, March 30.

The MJCI two-person, 36-hole scramble format tournament begins Saturday, March 31 and includes only the competing celebrities. The second and final round of the MJCI will be played Sunday, April 1. Additional festivities and special events surround the Saturday and Sunday competitions.

The Smith Center for the Performing Arts, a centerpiece of Las Vegas' reemerging downtown and reenergized dedication to cultural offerings in the city, is set to open March 10 following more than a decade of conceptualization, design, and construction. The world-class complex includes the 2,050-seat Reynolds Hall, 258-seat Cabaret Jazz overlooking 1.7-acre Symphony Park, 250-seat Troesh Studio Theater, and the iconic 17-story Carillon bell tower.

Performances ranging from Broadway productions to local and national musical and dance talent—including the Las Vegas Philharmonic, Las Vegas Symphony Orchestra, and Nevada Ballet Theatre—combine for a rich and diverse schedule of events throughout 2012. The center is expected to be the first Silver LEED-certified performing arts venue of its size in the country. Additionally, the campus will be the new location of the Discovery Children's Museum later this year. ▾

## Boulder City Fine Arts Festival




