BELLAGIO CONSERVATORY & BOTANICAL GARDENS

SPRING DISPLAY HONORS JAPANESE CULTURE.



Blooming cherry blossoms, peaceful waterfalls, and traditional Japanese architecture welcome the spring season to Bellagio's Conservatory & Botanical Gardens through May 14.

Upon entering the Japanese-themed spring display, guests embark on a journey of the senses beginning with a symbolic teahouse nestled among raked golden sand and cherry blossom trees in the East Garden. The 12-foot-tall house—made from bamboo and natural material and ornamented with mineral copper accents—honors Japan's cultural tea tradition, dating back to the ninth century. Inside the teahouse, a mesmerizing hand-made wreath named Senbazuro Nest, complete with 1,000 Origami cranes, delights the eyes and mind. Each delicate and colorful crane symbolizes peace, good health, and longevity. Intricately hand-painted with cherry blossoms and cranes, 14 colorful parasols float above the garden, visible from every vantage point.

A few steps away in the West Garden, the journey continues with two bamboo structured Tsukubai waterfalls that outline the path through a 30-foot dogwood tree covered with bright fuchsia leaves. The tranquil waterfalls flow from 16 feet above into a serene pond that plays home to 75 Koi fish. Above the walkway, in the heart of the tree, sits a deck made of redwood and bamboo-inspired railings that wrap around the structure. A pair of hand-made birds rest on

the railings while others sit atop two hanging bird houses. Among the fresh tulips and chrysanthemums, live canaries find their home in two intricately designed birdcages located on both sides of the garden.

Flowers bloom throughout the Conservatory, especially in the North Garden where visitors encounter an 18-foot-tall cherry blossom tree elegantly adorned with 300 acrylic blossoms and leaves. Just as in nature, no two blossoms are identical. Nearby, stretching seven feet in length is a topiary turtle made of 850 fresh cut roses, resting beside five rustic twig fountains covered in moss. Providing a warm glow to the garden after sunset are three hand-painted Japanese lanterns that hang above the cherry blossom tree.

Bellagio's Conservatory & Botanical Gardens is complimentary to the public and open 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Also, don't miss the Summer Garden Party, May 20-Sept. 10.






'YOUSUF KARSH: ICONS OF THE 20TH CENTURY'

Featuring iconic portraits of notable men and women in Hollywood, the arts, sports, and politics, “Yousuf Karsh: Icons of the 20th Century” at Bellagio Gallery of Fine Art (BGFA) is now open.

The exhibit—organized in partnership with the Museum of Fine Arts, Boston—showcases more than 60 portraits ranging from Alfred Hitchcock and Princess Elizabeth to Muhammad Ali and Audrey Hepburn. Each of the portraits is unique due to Karsh’s ability to capture the essence of the individual. He believed that each person he photographed had a hidden secret and it was his job to reveal it.

“Yousuf Karsh: Icons of the 20th Century” offers guests the opportunity to get up close and personal with a select few of Karsh’s world-renowned portraits and learn about his distinct style that reached beyond the subject’s face. Throughout his lifetime, Karsh produced

more than 50,000 original prints, some of which are now on display through Sept. 5. This is the first time in nearly a decade that BGFA is featuring a photography exhibit.

BGFA is open daily 10 a.m. to 8 p.m. Last admissions are sold 30 minutes prior to closing. Guests also may enjoy daily docent tours at 2 p.m., included with all paid admissions.

LEGENDS OF THE GAME CELEBRITY TOUR

For 20 years, Scott and Gracie Hampton have been creating a weekend of golf, entertainment, dining, and gaming fun that brings together some of the sporting world's top retired celebrities. This year's Legends of the Game Celebrity Tour happens in Reno June 3-5. The weekend is also an important fundraiser for area charities, and that is no coincidence.

Scott was a nurse working the night shift in the emergency room in a Northern California hospital. That career's impact was two-fold; he saw how pediatric programs always seemed to be hurting for money, and he ran into famous people. Recognizing the connection, he began setting up charity golf tournaments with doctors and a few celebrities. He put on an event in Reno, and liked the area so much, he and Gracie moved to Nevada.

Rick Upchurch—former wide receiver and kick returner for the Denver Broncos—has been playing in the tournament for the last four years, and for him, the event is a win-win.

"It's a lot of fun, and we're doing great things in the community," Rick says.

Also attending is Hall of Famer Tim Brown from the Oakland Raiders; George "The Iceman" Gervin from the San Antonio Spurs; Doug Williams from the Washington Redskins; Ed "Too Tall" Jones from the Dallas Cowboys; and Hall of Fame pitcher Ferguson Jenkins, among many others.

The golfing takes place at LakeRidge Golf Course—designed by Robert Trent Jones, Sr. The party moves to the Peppermill and Montbleu Casino, with each hotel hosting different events for the celebrities, golfers, and sponsors. On Friday, June 3 from 9-10 a.m., the public is invited to come to the golf course and watch the players and celebrities warm up during a live remote from CBS Sports Radio. And don't forget your camera, because it's the perfect time to get a selfie with your favorite sports hero.

Want to get even closer? Each day, two people can have lunch at the golf course with the celebrities, and will receive a program and the chance to get autographs. Ken Houston, a Hall of Famer from the Houston Oilers and Washington Redskins, is returning again this year, and thinks this tournament is unique from others he plays in.

"I've been coming maybe 8, 10 years, and it's a real family atmosphere," he says.

"It's why people come back year after year. If I'm not there, I get a call from the guys 'hey, why weren't you here?' Plus Nevada's just a great place to come to."

The players' camaraderie is what makes it special to Ed Halicki, former pitcher from the San Francisco Giants and the California Angels.

"I don't consider myself a celebrity," he says. "I'm just one of the guys. I like being able to meet different people and play with them. I like doing things that give back; I don't directly help, but I get to be a part of what Scott's doing."

Rick's favorite part?

"Everything. The whole thing is a class act. Everyone should come to this event and support it. Scott's doing such great things in the community. Plus, you can see if these guys can play golf," Rick says, jokingly.

This year's event benefits the Reno Firefighter Community Assistance program and the Nevada Diabetes Association. The tour has raised a half million dollars for local children's charities since its inception.

‘GHOST RAILROADS OF NEVADA’

NEVADA STATE RAILROAD MUSEUM HOSTS HAUNTINGLY HISTORIC LECTURE.

Jim’s interest in railroads is exemplified in his book: “Discovering the Ghost Railroads of Central Nevada.” The 48-page publication features color photos, GPS coordinates, and historical information from some of Nevada’s most famously forgotten rails. The book is available on Amazon and bookstores throughout the state.
