

NEVADA ASSEMBLY BILL 521 NET HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUM FILING REQUIREMENTS

Assembly Bill 521 became effective on July 16, 1997. Section 224 of this act requires carriers to file with the commissioner of insurance the net health insurance premium derived from health benefits plans delivered or issued for delivery to small employers and individuals in Nevada during the previous calendar year. Each carrier must file the following information prior to September 15, 1997:

- 1) 1996 net health insurance premium for health benefit plans delivered or issued for delivery to small employers size 2 to 50;
- 2) 1996 net health insurance premium for health benefit plans (including short-term, nonrenewable) delivered or issued for delivery to individuals;
- 3) 1996 net insurance premium for stop-loss coverage provided for health benefit plans which are employer-sponsored plans or plans established pursuant to the Labor-Management Relations Act, 1947, as amended; and
- 4) 1996 net health insurance premium for short-term, nonrenewable health benefit plans delivered or issued for delivery to individuals.
