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Mission Statement

The Washoe County School District sets out to create an education system where all students achieve academic success, develop personal and civic responsibility, and achieve career and college readiness for the 21st century.

Superintendent's Highlights

WCSD earned the highest graduation rate in district history, as 75 percent of our students earned their diplomas. In all, 3467 students crossed the graduation stage.

Rita Cannan Elementary School and Lemmon Valley Elementary School celebrated their 50th anniversaries with community events that highlighted the histories of their schools.

The WCSD launched a new, more efficient website that provides features for families, students, and members of the community to more easily find information about District programs, resources, and schools.

More than 8,500 people, including 3,335 runners, attended the 2014 Run for Education on October 26, 2014. This community-wide event was organized by the Education Alliance of Washoe County and raised \$207,000 through sponsorships, registrations, and in-kind donations to support physical and academic fitness for WCSD schools and students

WCSD Communications, School Police and Student Activities & Athletics partnered with the NIAA and launched the "Look.Listen. Let Someone Know" campaign to effectively convey the District's proactive approach to ensure safety of our students during sporting events.

The WCSD Board of Trustees approved the rebranding of our WCSD Adult Education Program to, "RISE Academy for Adult Achievement." This new name and logo highlight the positive changes that have occurred within the school over the past year. RISE Academy for Adult Achievement guides students over the age of 18, through a variety of programs, to earn an adult diploma so they may further their opportunities in higher education and highly skilled careers.

To complement the amazing, positive improvements that have been made to Washoe Innovations High School within the last year, the Board of Trustees approved for the school to be renamed, "Innovations High School." A committee comprised of staff, students, and community members helped in the renaming process. As the first "Big Picture Learning School" in Nevada, this updated name and image will reflect the school's unique offerings and the exciting changes that they continue to make.

The Board of Trustees appointed 15 members to the Safe and Healthy Schools Commission. The Commission is comprised of a dedicated group of community members who will advise Trustees on issues relating to the safety and security of schools, reviewing District policies and procedures, and recommending changes where needed.

Volunteer Services completed the Nevada Volunteers' (Governor's Commission on Volunteerism in Nevada) National Service Enterprise training, preparing them to pursue a national certification as a nationally certified volunteer program site in Nevada. Volunteer Services launched a second five year AmeriCorps Volunteers In-Service To America (VISTA) program called, "First Teacher Trainings" that will focus on providing parent and volunteer trainings at school sites and in the community to help parents and volunteers support students in their homes and at school sites. Volunteer Services Read & Succeed Incentive Book Program has distributed over \$147,000 in take-home books.

The Americorps VISTA program has also provided 22 Summer VISTA tutors to support Zoom school summer intersession, high school intersessions and then support back-to school needs and registration. Mostly college students from University of Nevada, Reno and Truckee Meadows Community College, these special volunteers contribute 35 hours a week to help. Five of these Summer VISTAs are also doing summer feeding with the Food Bank of Northern Nevada in local parks.

Volunteer Services hosts the Nevada KickStart program that guarantees every kindergarten a \$50.00 college account plus a \$15.00 529 College fund. The KickStart Team reached 34 elementary schools in Washoe County and had the highest

registration of kindergarteners for 2014.

The Grants Department wrote 162 grants (federal, state and private) in SY 14-15 and was awarded 134 for an overall success rate of 82.7%. State and federal grants applied for totaled 80 and 67 were awarded for an 83.75% success rate. Private grants applied for totaled 82 and 67 were awarded for an 81.7% success rate.

The Child and Family Services Department Early Childhood Education (ECE) Program and the Grants Department worked in collaboration with the NDE in development of the US DOE PreK Development Grant. Nevada was one of five states to receive this grant award, called Nevada Ready! PreK Development Grant. This four-year grant will expand existing half-day PreK classrooms to full-day and also create new full-day PreK classrooms. Overall, Nevada will increase its preschool population by 58% over four years, serving approximately 15% of the state's four-year-old population living under 200% poverty level. The Child and Family Services Department ECE Program will work closely with the Grants Department to implement this grant.

The WCSD brought on eight new Title I schools during the 2014-15 school year (Dodson ES, Donner Springs ES, Drake ES, Dunn ES, Lemmon Valley ES, O'Brien MS, Alice Smith ES, and Sparks HS). This increased the number of WCSD school receiving Title I services from 33 to 41.

2014-15 Performance Outcomes

The District had the strongest performance ever on the graduation rate. This includes a significant narrowing of the achievement gap in nearly all student populations. What is more, half of our graduates earned advanced /honors diplomas.

3,467 students earned their high school diplomas during the 2014-2015 school year, setting a new record for the WCSD. Every comprehensive high school had over 70% graduation rate, and most have passed the 80% mark.

Science had increases across the board in student populations in middle school by 4 percentage points, narrowing the achievement gap. It is worth noting that Science is the only CRT not impacted by a shift to CCSS type assessment items.

For the first time all 11th grade students took the ACT test in 2014-2015 and outperformed the entire state.

AP participation continues to increase in WCSD. The percent of college credit in AP and dual credit classes increased by 4 percentage points, this is true for race and ethnic groups as well, marching us toward our goal of narrowing the achievement gap.

The school district continues to work toward and has seen a narrowing of the gap between Title I and non-Title I schools in terms of teacher experience and the percentage of teachers with advanced educational degrees.

Our Zoom schools have shown positive results in language and literacy development.

2014-2015 Recognitions and Awards

Caughlin Ranch Elementary School was named a National Blue Ribbon School by the US Department of Education. This recognition honors public and private elementary, middle, and high schools where students perform at very high levels or where significant improvements are being made in students' levels of achievement. This is the third Blue Ribbon School named in WCSD in the past two years.

Scott Bailey, Chief Academic Officer at WCSD, received an esteemed Learning in Practice Award on behalf of WCSD from Chief Learning Officer magazine. He was awarded the Silver Innovation Award for accomplishments in applying innovative development practices to address significant business opportunities.

WCSD chose three principals as principals of the year for 2015: Joe Ernst, principal of Anderson Elementary School; Gina Leonhard, principal of Yvonne Shaw Middle School; and Jeana Curtis, principal of North Valleys High School. These principals were recognized by the WCSD Board of Trustees at the Spotlight on Success Ceremony on April 21, 2014.

Gina Leonhard, principal of Yvonne Shaw Middle School, were named Middle School Principal of the Year for Nevada by the Secondary School Principals' Association of Nevada (SSPAN).

WCSD, the Robert and Dorothy Keyser Foundation, and the Washoe Education Association honored veteran teacher Ana Herrera with the 2015 Keyser Foundation WCSD Teacher of the Year award. Herrera has taught in the District for nine years, and currently teaches AP biology and AP environmental science at Hug High School. Two other teachers, Jennifer Hoy of Swope Middle School and Brenda Petrelli of Anderson Elementary School, were honored as finalists for the award.

The Nevada School Counselor Association recognized Shannon Quinn (RiSE Academy for Adult Achievement) as Nevada's 2014-2015 High School Adult Counselor of the year; Ashley Brezina (Mount Rose K-8 School of Languages) as Nevada's Elementary Counselor of the Year; Nancy Berdrow, Bill Fong, and Shinae Watterson (Sparks Middle School) as Nevada's Middle School Counselors of the Year; and Gina Leonhard (Yvonne Shaw Middle School) as Nevada's Administrator of the Year. These statewide recognitions by the Nevada School Counselor Association are phenomenal!

Ryan Smith from Reed High School was named Nevada Teacher of the Year by the Southwest Conference on Language Teaching. This award honors an individual who elevates the status of the language teaching profession at the local, state, and regional levels.

Eight Nevada high schools competed in Las Vegas for the 2015 "We the People" state competition. Congratulations to Reed High School for earning first place, Incline High School for earning second place, and Reno High School for earning third place.

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These students and teachers are shining stars and represent the great achievements happening in our District.

Thirteen high school students in WCSD were named semifinalists in the 2015 National Merit Scholarship Program. They were among approximately 16,000 scholars nationwide who had the opportunity to continue competing for more than \$33 million in college scholarships.

The Hug High School JROTC Leadership Team competed at the final championship event of the 2015 Army JROTC Leadership Bowl Championship in Washington D.C. The team was one of only 40 Army JROTC Academic Bowl teams in the nation to advance to the finals.

A team of students from Galena High School designed adaptive equipment for their fellow students who have disabilities, which placed Galena High School among five national grand prize winners in the Samsung nationwide Solve for Tomorrow contest. Galena High School was chosen from more than 3,100 schools across the country, and will receive \$120,000 in Samsung technology and other prizes bringing the total award value to \$138,000.

WCSD was one of 21 school districts in the country to receive the US Department of Education Project Prevention Grant, a five-year grant to help children exposed to pervasive violence. WCSD expects to receive more than \$4 million as a result of the successful grant application.

WCSD received the 2015 "Best Communities for Music Education" designation. This recognition is a tremendous honor as it acknowledges our District and teachers for their outstanding commitment to music education.

The Sierra Nevada Chapter of the Public Relations Society of America honored WCSD's Communications Department with the Award of Excellence for creating a tribute video that highlighted all WCSD high school principals who are committed to the success of students.

The National Procurement Institute, Inc. recognized the Washoe County School District for its fiscal responsibility for the 13th consecutive year with its Achievement of Excellence in Procurement Award. This award recognizes organizational excellence in procurement, innovation, professionalism, e-procurement, productivity, and leadership attributes. WCSD was one of just six governmental agencies in Nevada and one of only 23 school districts in the United States to receive the award in 2014.

For the 14th consecutive year, the Washoe County School District (WCSD) was recognized for fiscally responsible practices by the Government Finance Officers Association (GFOA). The group awarded its Certification of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting to the WCSD Office of Business & Financial Services in recognition of its award-winning Comprehensive Financial Report (CAFR) for fiscal year ending June 30, 2014.

Employer Support of the Guard and Reserve (ESGR), a Department of Defense office, announced that WCSD was one of 15 recipients of the 2015 Secretary of Defense Employer Support Freedom Award, the highest recognition given to employers for exceptional support of Guard and Reserve employees. WCSD was nominated by ANG Col. David Clark, a teacher at Sparks Middle School, who praised the District for the support showed after a fellow Guardsman and teacher in Washoe County was killed while defending students during a shooting at Sparks Middle School.

The US Environmental Protection Agency awarded WCSD \$110,000 to replace five older diesel school buses with new, clean buses that are more than 90 percent cleaner. WCSD was among 76 recipients nationwide that received rebates through the EPA's Diesel Emissions Reduction Act (DERA) funding to replace 201 school buses.

Goals and Objectives

1. Provide all students with extensive opportunities, challenges, and support in achieving continuous academic success.
2. Recruit, select, develop, and retain highly-effective personnel to provide the best educational opportunities and services for all students.
3. Engage family and community members in strong relationships and meaningful opportunities to increase expertise, trust, and shared responsibility for student success.
4. Value and strengthen a positive, productive, self-renewing culture throughout the district with attention to safe, orderly, and respectful learning and work environments focused on student achievement.
5. Align and maintain efficient and effective performance systems to sustain a cycle of continuous improvement in support of student learning.

District Communication Efforts

The following was accomplished in engagement during the 2015-2016 school year in support of the Washoe County School District's (WCSD) strategic plan, *Envision 2015 – Investing in our Future*. The District's Family-School Partnership Office works in collaboration with the District's Council on Family Engagement to implement district-wide initiatives for family engagement which included:

- Title I funds and provides supports to Parent Involvement Facilitators hired at each of the district's Title I schools in order to provide families academic support and fulfill the vision of ESEA section 1118.
- Title I and other key departments provided professional development Parent Involvement Facilitators, teachers and administrators through district programs such as Washoe Academy of School Leaders and Saturday CAFEs.

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- Tracked Parent Involvement Facilitator academic contacts with families in Infinite Campus Student Information System to provide continuous improvement and focus of the PIF position on supporting families with their child's academic achievement. Improved this process so schools can now pull their own reports in the district's data warehouse.
- WCSD's Striving Readers grant has provided specific support to numerous schools on family literacy including but not limited to: 6-week action plans for family literacy, videos and tip sheets on how to support literacy at home, family field trips to the Washoe County library and campaigns to increase the number of families who have library cards. The grant has also provided support on data nights and implementation with family engagement plans.
- Continued the fourth year of the WCSD Parent University to provide 300 free classes to families focused on how to support a child's learning at home, how to understand data and your child's progress as well as support for college and career readiness. Classes are taught in schools and community based locations and offer free childcare and interpretation.
- Parent University also offered two Family Access Days held at the University of Nevada, Reno in partnership with UNR and Truckee Meadows Community College. The Family Access Days provided families with an all-day Saturday workshop on the path to college from pre-k through high school.
- Supported all schools to create a comprehensive plan for family engagement incorporated into the School Performance Plan as part of the district's School Performance Framework. Each plan was scored and provided feedback on their plan.
- A partnership with the Children's Cabinet has placed full-time and part-time Family Graduation Advocates in 9 high schools to positively outreach to the families of 9th grade students who are "high risk" on the district's Risk Index and support the families to monitor their child's progress through the Infinite Campus Parent Portal and navigate the educational system for their children.
- Support is provided for the district's Council on Family Engagement, an advisory volunteer board that works in partnership with the district on WCSD's family engagement efforts. The Council makes recommendations to the Board of Trustees about best practices that should be implemented to support the board policy on family engagement. The Council has five committees that also work in partnership with the district. These committees include: Assessment, Parent University, Family Friendly Walk-throughs, Professional Development and Policy & Operations.
- The WCSD COFE's Family Friendly schools committee provided walk-throughs for a third of the district's schools that will receive reports with suggestions on how to improve the family friendly environment at their schools.
- The WCSD COFE's Professional Development committee finished designing a 15 hour class on family engagement for teachers and other school personnel. The first two offerings of this course were completed in the spring of 2015.
- Continued a district-wide Parent Climate Survey aligned with the student and staff survey. Continued the use of paper surveys to ensure that all parents had an equitable chance of providing input. Collaborated with the WCSD Council on Family Engagement in the design of the survey questions and the communications plan. Climate data is reported back to schools individually and is also used for district foundational goals.
- Supported the positive Parent Teacher Home Visit Program in 20 schools and Academic Parent Teacher Teams in 6 schools. The district is on-track to complete its goal of 1,800 positive home visits in WCSD this school year.

Discipline

It is the mission of the Washoe County School District to create an education system where all students achieve academic success, develop personal and civic responsibility, and achieve career and college readiness for the 21st century.

The mission of the Office of Student Supports is to provide a clear vision and leadership by:

- Develop and implement positive behavioral interventions and supports for all students
- Create a framework of support for staff and students for guiding disciplinary procedures & actions
- Communicate and collaborate with internal and external stakeholders in order to support students and educators in the social and emotional success for all students

To accomplish our mission, during the 2014-2015 school year the District took several steps to decrease the number of major behavioral incidents, as well as the number of incidents related to bullying or cyber bullying.

First, the District continued to address bullying, cyber-bullying or harassment by continuing to promote reporting mechanisms for students, family or community members, or staff. Reporting systems include but are not limited to a reporting button, "The Bully Free Zone" or a complaint form both of which are available on the WCSD website, reporting any incident in person, and Secret Witness. All WCSD staff received on-going training on available reporting mechanisms, how to respond once a report is made, and any procedural updates regarding bullying.

An on-going practice the District engages in is to provide a Behavioral Matrix to support administrators in disciplinary actions. The Matrix outlines possible behavioral incidents, provides suggested progressive steps in disciplinary actions and intervention options and resources for the student. This document is reviewed and revised by a multi-disciplinary team and all administrators receive annual training on the Behavioral Matrix.

Additionally, WCSD has revised the draft Board Policy 5100, which states its Board of Trustees believe every student has the right to learn in a respectful, safe and inclusive learning environment and that every teacher has the right to teach in an environment free from distractions and disruptions that impede learning. The home, school, and community must work together to enhance the quality of the educational experience of all of our students in all of our schools. A positive school climate characterized by high expectations for student behavior will allow for academic and social emotional growth for all students.

Based on the extensive 2014-2015 review process of the discipline data, including examining data re: students referred to behavior hearings, the types of incidents, and interventions provided prior to an incident (where appropriate), and disproportionality, the District made changes to how it supports students with behavioral concerns. WCSD has formed a District-level multi-disciplinary team which includes central office administrators and community representation to staff each student within WCSD that has not committed a NRS violation requiring an emergency suspension and discipline hearing. This new process has resulted in a notable decrease in emergency suspensions and an increase in coordinated supports to students, families and schools.
