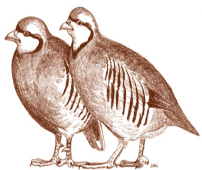

SNOWCOCK		
SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Sept. 3 - Nov. 30, 2005	Elko - Units 101, 102, and 103, and that portion of White Pine County in Unit 103	2/2

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
LIMIT: Persons planning to hunt snowcocks must obtain a snowcock free use permit from the Department of Wildlife’s Eastern Region Office at 60 Youth Center Road, Elko, NV 89801. Phone (775) 777-2300. Permits can also be e-mailed to the hunter from the Elko Office.
OPEN to nonresidents.

Hunting on Wildlife Management Areas

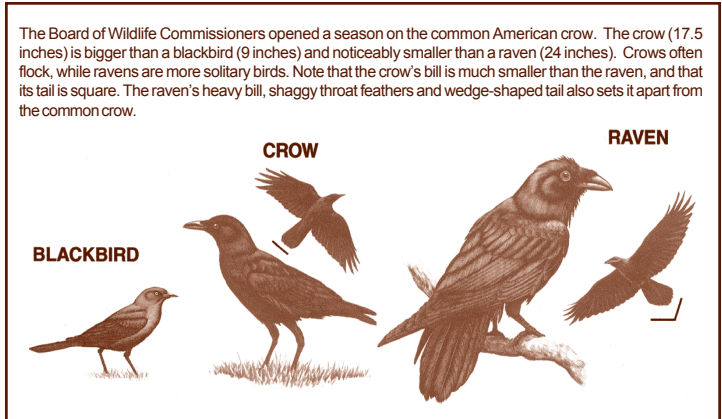
Non-toxic shot must be used for all species when hunting on wildlife management areas. (NAC 503.183)

The use or possession of shells for a shotgun containing shot that is toxic, or larger than standard-sized T is prohibited on the Overton, Key Pittman, W.E. Kirch, Scripps, Mason Valley, Fernley, Alkali Lake, Humboldt, Steptoe Valley and Franklin Lake Wildlife Management Areas (NAC 504.135)

The use of shotguns capable of holding more than three shells is prohibited on all wildlife management areas unless it has been plugged with a one-piece filler, incapable of removal without disassembling the gun so its total capacity does not exceed three shells. (NAC 504.135)

SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Sept. 1 - Nov. 17, 2005 and March 1 - April 15, 2006	Statewide	10

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset daily. **Shotguns only.**
OPEN to nonresidents.
NOTE: All crows must be retrieved and removed from the field.
Season closed on common ravens. See illustration.



Attention Upland Game Bird Hunters

An upland game bird stamp is now required for anyone age 12 or older, to hunt upland game birds - except turkey, dove and crow. The stamp, which sells for \$10 is available at NDOW offices and authorized license agents statewide. Funds from the stamp sales are used to support guzzler maintenance and habitat work that benefits upland game bird species.

Oct. 8, 2005 - Jan. 31, 2006	Statewide	10/20 (See mountain quail limit information under Special Regulations/ Information below)

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
LIMIT: Limit singly or in the aggregate, except for mountain quail where limits may not include more than two daily and four in possession.
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset daily.
OPEN to nonresidents.

UPLAND GAME BIRD, RABBIT, DOVE AND CROW

SEASONS AND LIMITS REGULATIONS



Please see the 2005 *Nevada Hunt Book* for laws and regulations, and to find the NDOW office nearest you.

HUNTING HOURS FOR UPLAND GAME BIRDS AND RABBITS ARE SUNRISE TO SUNSET with exceptions as indicated in SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION under each season table.

UNITS REFERENCED are Game Management Units described in NAC 504.210 and are shown on the **2005 *Nevada Hunt Book*** map.

NOTE: Only English house sparrows and European starlings are classified as unprotected. As such, they may be hunted year around.

SAGE GROUSE

BLUE AND RUFFED GROUSE

SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Sept. 3 - Nov. 30, 2005	Statewide	2/4

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
LIMIT: Limit singly or in the aggregate.
OPEN to nonresidents.
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset.
SPECIES IDENTIFICATION: The head or one fully feathered wing must be attached to all blue and ruffed grouse until the carcass reaches the possessor’s residence or a commercial facility for its preservation.
Persons harvesting ruffed grouse in Humboldt County are requested to report harvest to the Department of Wildlife’s Winnemucca sub-office at 815 E. Fourth St., Winnemucca, NV 89445; (775) 623-6565.



ATTENTION SAGE GROUSE HUNTERS

As part of a long-term study of the state’s sage grouse populations, hunters are asked to remove one wing from each sage grouse taken. Please keep the wing dry and away from flies, deposit in a paper lunch sack and drop it off in any of the Department’s wing barrels, at check stations, or with NDOW employees. Thank you for your assistance.



PHEASANT

SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Nov. 5 - Dec. 4, 2005	Statewide	2/4 Cocks only

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
OPEN to nonresidents.
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset.

SPECIAL FALCONRY SEASONS

SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Sept. 1, 2005 - Jan. 31, 2006	Statewide	2/2

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset daily.
OPEN to nonresidents.
NOTE: Season applies to all rabbits and resident upland game species except turkey and sharp-tailed grouse. The taking of sage grouse by falconry is only allowed in those areas where there is an open season.
Limits: Singly or in the aggregate.

MOURNING AND WHITE-WINGED DOVE*

SEASON DATES (INCLUSIVE)	OPEN COUNTIES	LIMITS DAILY/POSSESSION
Sept. 1- 30, 2005	Statewide*	10/20

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
HUNTING HOURS for dove are one-half hour before sunrise to sunset daily.
Shotguns must be plugged to limit overall shotshell capacity to **3** when hunting dove.
***White-winged dove season is closed in all counties except Clark and Nye Counties.**
OPEN to nonresidents.
Limits: Limits for mourning dove and white-wing dove singly or in aggregate in Clark and Nye Counties.
HIP Requirements: Any person 12 years or older who hunts dove is required to obtain a Harvest Information Program number **ANNUALLY** by calling 1-866-703-4605, or on the Internet at www.ndow.org under “Hunting, Waterfowl & Migratory Birds.”
Note: Reservations are required on the Moapa Valley portion of the Overton WMA on opening day and the first weekend of the season.

RABBIT

(cottontail, pygmy, white-tailed jackrabbit)

SPECIAL REGULATIONS/INFORMATION
Limits: Limit singly or in aggregate.
OPEN to nonresidents.
HUNTING HOURS: Sunrise to sunset.
