ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Any person of any age who sells raw furs of any kind, whether taken by trap or firearm, is required to purchase a trapping license. The following species can be hunted without a hunting license in Nevada, but a trapping license is required to trap them: coyote, black-tailed jackrabbit, badger, weasel, spotted skunk, striped skunk, raccoon and ring-tailed cat.

2011-2012 Furbearer dates and limits are set by the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners in CR 07-07, CR 07-07 Amendment #2, Amendment #3, Amendment #6 and Amendment #7.

Per NAC 504.340 many areas of the State are closed to hunting. Please review the *Nevada Hunting Guide* for the list of closed areas.
