Oct. 1, 2013 - March 31, 2014	Elko Eureka Humboldt Lander Pershing Open to Nonresidents	Counties closed to otter trapping: Carson City, Churchill, Clark Douglas, Esmeralda, Lincoln, Lyon, Mineral, Nye Storey, Washoe and White Pine

Special Regulations: If an otter is accidentally trapped or killed in those counties which are closed or outside the prescribed season, the person trapping or killing it shall report the trapping or killing within 48 hours to a representative of the Department of Wildlife. The animal must be disposed of in accordance with the instructions of the representative.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: Any person of any age who sells raw furs of any kind, whether taken by trap or firearm, is required to purchase a trapping license. The following species can be hunted without a hunting license in Nevada, but a trapping license is required to trap them: coyote, black-tailed jackrabbit, badger, weasel, spotted skunk, striped skunk, raccoon and ring-tailed cat.

2013-2014 Furbearer dates and limits are set by the Nevada Board of Wildlife Commissioners in CR 12-06.

Per NAC 502.347 - A person shall not possess a pelt of a bobcat 10 days or more after the close of the season unless the Department's seal is permanently attached to the pelt.

Las Vegas	February 13 (8 a.m. - 5 p.m.) and March 10 (1 p.m. - 5 p.m.) at NDOW Office.
Panaca	February 13 (8 a.m. - 5 p.m.) at Nevada State Parks - NDOW Office.
Tonopah	February 13 (8 a.m. - 5 p.m.) and March 10 (1 p.m. - 5 p.m.) at NDOW Office.
Winnemucca	January 30 (8 a.m. - 1 p.m.) at NDOW Office.
