## REPORT OF SUPERINTENDENT

*To the Honorable Board of Directors of the Nevada State Orphans' Home.*

GENTLEMEN: I herewith respectfully submit to you my biennial report of the administration of the Nevada State Orphans' Home for the years of 1921-1922.

### **COST OF MAINTENANCE**

The cost of maintenance for the past two years, based on actual expenditures for maintenance and upkeep, deducting only the \$500 for education—paid out of this appropriation, that was due for the last quarter of 1920 and is not a charge against this term—and such other expenditures as are assets and permanent improvements, is 73 <sup>7</sup>/<sub>10</sub> cents per day, or \$22.42 per month per child, and covers education, food, clothing, entertainment, physical and surgical attention, salaries, repairs and upkeep, etc.

There has been collected from the several counties of the State, for the care of children and paid into the State Treasury, the sum of \$19,914.80.

### **REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS**

Numerous necessary improvements and repairs have been made during the term, including the installation of a fuel oil-burning cooking range, the old range being worn out and unserviceable. An oil burner was installed in the hot water heater, in lieu of the coal burner, thereby saving at least 50 per cent in fuel and greatly increasing efficiency.

The large dome on the main building, the swimming pool and garage buildings, the 12-foot-high, solid board fence separating the boys and girls yards, the cornice on the gymnasium and 2,250 feet of picket fence were given two coats of paint and the roofs of the large barn, gymnasium, swimming pool, garage and a part of the main building one coat of paint, in addition to all other necessary repairs and upkeep.

### **POPULATION**

At the beginning of the term we had 90 children enrolled and at the end of the term we have 111, with a daily average for the years of 1921-1922 of 106, the highest in the history of the Home. There were 53 children received and 32 released during the term. The daily average for the preceding term was 94 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>, showing a daily average increase of 12 per cent.

It is more than probable that the population will increase during the ensuing term.

### **HEALTH OF CHILDREN**

The health of the children has been exceptionally good during this term, not a single case of severe illness or an epidemic of any kind whatsoever occurring. There have been quite a few operations for removal of tonsils and adenoids, many of the children received requiring this attention.

During the last nine months the entire cost for physician and surgeon has been only \$92.

**RECOMMENDATIONS**

I would earnestly recommend the purchase, if possible, of pasturage land for the dairy cows. It is quite important that pasturage be had, both for the benefit of the stock and economy.

Available rent pasturage is now very uncertain. There are one or two pieces of land that might be purchased for a very reasonable price and I would recommend that this matter be considered.

The plastered ceiling in the gymnasium, formerly the school-house, is in a shaky condition on account of the plaster being broken and loose and occasionally dropping, and not suitable for the rough usage of a gymnasium. I would recommend that the old plaster be removed and the ceiling ship-lapped and painted, thereby making it more safe and durable.

As the matter of appropriations are taken up under the budget system, I will not include them in this report.

In conclusion, I wish to thank your Honorable Board for your kind considerations and assistance.

**REPAIRS AND IMPROVEMENTS**

Numerous necessary improvements and repairs have been made during the term, including the installation of a fuel oil-burning cooking range, the old range being worn out and unserviceable. An oil burner was installed in the hot water heater, in lieu of the coal burner, thereby saving at least 50 per cent in fuel and greatly increasing efficiency. The large dome on the main building, the swimming pool and garage building, the 12-foot high solid board fence separating the boys and girls tracks, the cornice on the gymnasium and 2,500 feet of board fence were given two coats of paint and the walls of the large bath room and swimming pool, garage and a part of the main building were given a coat of paint in addition to all other necessary repairs and improvements.

**POPULATION**

At the beginning of the term we had 99 children enrolled and at the end of the term we have 111, with a daily average for the year of 105. This is the highest in the history of the Home. There were 56 children received and 32 released during the term. The daily average for the population term was 111, showing a daily average increase of 12 per cent.

**HEALTH OF CHILDREN**

The health of the children has been exceptionally good during the term, with a single case of severe illness as an exception. In fact, the children have been quite a few months free from any serious illness and abundant many of the children have been able to attend school during the term.
